Dear Mr. Nebeker:

On July 20, 1994, a field examination was completed on the water diversion trespass. The water diversion structure was removed as agreed. As a result, the water diversion case file will be closed and considered resolved.

The culinary water pipeline trespass file (IDI-30492) is still active. We will be contacting you at a later date to resolve this matter. Your right-of-way application for this water pipeline has been received and serialized (IDI-30486). Upon resolution of the trespass case, we will start processing the right-of-way.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that we will need to have proof of water rights before the culinary water pipeline right-of-way can be issued. According to Mr. Brochu with the Corp. of Engineers, you do not currently hold a water right for the culinary water. He stated that you would need to file for those water rights. I suggest that you contact him or the Idaho Dept. of Water Resources for further information.

If you have any questions, please feel free to call Debbie Kovar at our office. Thank you for your cooperation in the removal of the water diversion structure. We look forward to working with you on the remaining actions.
