To whom it may concern:





MEMORANDUM

TO: WATER DISTRICT 11 FILE
FROM: NORM YOUNG *NY*
RE: JAMES SMITH CALL FOR WATER
DATE: June 29, 1999

Pete Peterson called today to discuss how to respond to Mr. Smith's letter (attached). He confirmed that the ditch delivering the water (Lloyd Ditch) was dammed off preventing delivery from the headgate on the river to Mr. Smith's place of use. He also confirmed his observations that his records show delivery and billing for use on the Smith property and that he had observed irrigation of the land a few years ago.

We agreed that Pete would respond in writing that the rights requested for delivery were still in the Department's records as decreed rights and would be delivered unless advised differently by the court. He would also respond that the rights would be delivered in priority (there is more than enough flow to do so at this time) when the dam was removed from the ditch allowing water to be carried to the place of use.
