WAL MEETING WATER DISTRICT 95-C MINUTES / MARCH 21, 1994

TWINLOW CHURCH CAMP TWIN LAKES, IDAHO

The meeting was called to order by Mildred Allen, President, at 7:04 PM.

Fifteen people were in attendance, including Al Beardsley of the Water

Rewources Department.

Minutes of the March 15, 1993 meeting were read and approved as amended.

Kootenai County Auditor's Report: balance on hand \$3,005.

Mildred Allen announced the sad news of the death of Orland Pupo, our Water Master. Water District 95-C and all of Twin Lakes will miss Orland very much.

Jeff Royer, Alternate Water Master will assume the position of Water Master. He announced the Lake Level as of today is 9.7. The gate will be opened to allow for the Spring run-off.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Letter from John Homan, Assistant State Attorney General in Boise, to Mr. Easterday re / permission to cross his property to measure Fish Creek.

Letter from Mildred Allen to Bob Haynes, Coeur d'Alene Department of Water Resources, re / metering of those who pump more than .2 cu ft per second.

OLD BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS:

Al Beardsley sent twenty letters to those that the records indicate water usage over .2 cu ft per second and received four responses. Some indicated that their usage is not as much as the Water Rights listed. He will follow up by telephone. On the purchase of a meter for Fish Creek, the best buy would be a portable meter for \$1,057 from Science Institute of Milwaukee, Wi. with delivery in 10 days. This is the same meter as the one loaned to us by Water Resources Department last year. They will order. Jeff Royer felt other creeks coming into the Lake should also be metered, and Al Beardsley concurred.

Mildred Allen explained that because of the difference in tax dates and our mandated meeting date, we should submit the request for an asssessment of a total of \$3000 for two years.

Ben Moore moved to ses the Water District patrons r a total of \$3000 for two years. Emmet Gumm seconded the motion. After considerable discussion and clarification, the motion passed.
