The minutes of the 1998 meeting were accepted as written.

It was moved and seconded that Patt Aldous serve as Chairman. It was passed unanimously.

ADVISORY AND CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE

RESOLUTIONS

It was moved by Joe Proksch and seconded by Edgar Edwards that the following resolutions govern our district for the upcoming year. It was passed unanimously.

- A: That the next annual meeting will be held on the first Monday of March 2000---that date being March 6, 2000---at 2:00 P.M. at the Salmon Valley Center.
- C: That all assessments are due and payable by June 1, 1999, and said amounts not paid at that date shall be charged an annual interest rate of 8%. Assessments shall be payable to the Lemhi County Treasurer.

- D: That the assessment must be paid before any user shall receive water.
- E: That the Water Masters shall serve year round.

WATER MASTERS AND SECRETARY/TREASURER

It was moved by Joe Proksch and seconded by Dale Edwards that the people that now serve as water masters, assistant water master, and secretary/treasurer remain the same as in 1997 & 1998 years, being Mickey Verbeck as Summer Water Master, Paul Stokes as assistant Summer Water Master and Winter Water Master, and Patt Aldous as Secretary/Treasurer. The motion passed unanimously.

Francis DeMond wanted it noted that he felt that at some time in the future there could be a conflict of interest with the City of Salmon employees acting as water masters.

There being no furthur business, the meeting was adjourned until the first Monday in March, 2000.
