MINUTES OF WATER DISTRICT 74-Z ANNUAL MEETING HELD MONDAY, MARCH 2, 1998 AT 2:00 P.M. AT THE CITY BUILDING, LEADORE, IDAHO.

The following members of the Water District were in attendance:

Ralph McRea, Faul Mangini

Allan Furcell Tom Udy

James Whittaker Cal Whittaker

's Chairman, Bruce McConnell, was absent, the meeting was called to order by Ralph McRea, who read the minutes of last year's meeting, which was approved as written.

It was reported that the foot bridge across Big Eight Mile had been repaired by Ralph McRea, Tom Udy, and Kenneth Peterson last year for the Matermaster to cross to measure and adjust water.

In the matter of a budget for the coming year, after reviewing the Mater-master's 1998 Proposed Budget, and after subtracting the 1997 (redits and adding the 1997 Debits, and along with what was carried over in the bank, it came to slightly more than the proposed budget, so a motion was made to adopt the Matermaster's budget as proposed. Seconded and approved.

Allen Furcell made a motion to keep the salary, Travel expenses, and annual report the same as last year, which was \$300.00 per month Salary, \$450.00 equipment rental (travel) and \$40.00 for the yearly Watermaster Report. Seconded by Tom Udy and approved by the group.

It was proposed and approved to again have the Lemhi County Treasurer bill and collect the District's water tax monies from the District's water users for this adopted budget and then disburse the funds to the Water District's Treasurer for the payment of the District's obligations.

In the matter of hiring a watermaster for the 1998 season, there were 2 applications for the job. Richard Moll, and Rick Anderson. After some discusion, a motion was made to keep and rehire Richard Moll as Watermaster. Seconded and approved.

A motion was made by Tom Udy to have the date of May 1, 1998, taxkaxa the Matermaster go on and start measuring water, but may be signed on as early as April 1, 1998 if needed, at the request of one water user, in conformity with Idaho State law, and to serve until October 1, 1998, at which time he may be signed on to serve an additional length of time, but not to exceed October 31, 1998. Seconded by Allen Furcell and approved by the group.

It was proposed and approved to retain all those items from last year's minutes pertaining to the good management and pperating practices of the water district. They are:

- h. That the watermaster turn in each month's records prior to getting paid each month.
- ?. That the watermaster start measuring water at 8:00 A.M. when stream flow is on the increase, and that measurement be made between 10:00 A.M. and 12 Noon when stream flow is on the decrease, but allowing some flexibility for the watermaster to use his own discretion as to the need of the district.

- 3. As has always been done, all water in the creeks over and above the existing water rights be divided proportionaly to the existing rights and decrees by the watermaster.
- 4. That the watermaster may call upon the owner for assistance in getting water into or out of a ditch.

In the selection of officers for 1998, the following were approved.

Bruce McConnell, Chairman Cal Whittaker, Secretary/Treasurer

Leslie Young, Advisory Committee James Whittaker, Advisory Committee Ralph McRea, Advisory Committee

Amotion was made to have the amount of assessment to each water user as shown on the adopted 1998 budget become due and payable May 1, 1998, and that amounts if not so paid shall bear interest at the rate of 10% per annum as of May 1st of the year payment is due, until paid. Approved.

As there was no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:00 P.M.
