RE: KAGEL HEADGATE ON HAWLEY CREEK

I have had recent conversations with personnel from the ASCS offices in Arco and Salmon on the history of their involvement with assistance for construction of the headgate on Hawley Creek for Ray and Nancy Kagel. It appears from their records that Nancy Kagel first contacted ASCS (Salmon) on March 3, 1994 for an appointment and then soon after cancelled the appointment. The next contact appears to be June 30, 1994 when Ray phoned the Salmon office to file an application for cooperative assistance on building a headgate. That application was approved by ASCS on July 28, 1994 and the project completion is listed as June 6, 1995.

The ASCS stated that total cost of the headgate was \$1,110 of which they (ASCS) paid \$869 or approximately 75% of the cost. It seems then that the cost to the Kagels was \$241.
