

The 2000 irrigation season was a very dry year. Taylor Canal was turned off June 14th to accommodate users down stream.

The streams held up better than expected but were still below capacity. Most smaller ditches did not have enough water to accommodate irrigation.

Taylor Canal was turned back on July 18th and all water down stream lowered substantially. W.O.D. ditch went dry July 19th.

The total of all diversions for the season as determined from attached diversion summary list was 1099.94 24-hr second feet delivered.
