DEAR JOHN AMONSON:

A copy of this letter is being sent to each Mill Creek water user. For many years, including this year (1995), Mill Creek has been impossible to control effectively or with any real degree of accuracy.

In some instances effectively controllable and easily adjustable head-gates and diversions are non-existent. In other instances they are effectively controllable and easily adjustable in name only. At the present time, there are only three headgates on the entire creek that qualify as effectively controllable and easily adjustable.

The past and present use of rocks, boulders, sod, strawbales and canvas dams to control and adjust the waters of Mill Creek is both ineffective and inaccurate and can be dangerous as well. As your watermaster, it is my desire to do a first class job of controlling and regulating the waters of Mill Creek - but, under current conditions this is an impossibility.

With the current situation as a basis, I am formally requesting that you install fully controllable and easily adjustable headgates and diversions in all instances. These requested changes and improvements to be completed to the watermaster's satisfaction no later that October 31, 1995.

In support of my request, I am enclosing a copy of section 6 of the Water-master's Handbook entitled "Headgates, Controlling Works and Measuring Devices."

For my part, I will gladly work with and cooperate with each of you to insure that the results of your efforts are something we can both be happy with and proud of. It is my sincere desire that we satisfactorily accomplish the necessary changes and improvements on a local level without the need to involve the Idaho Department of Water Resources.

I look forward to working with you - to make Mill Creek the best instead of the worst creek to work with and regulate.
