RE: REQUEST FOR APPOINTMENT AS LOCAL COMMITTEE TO RENT WATER

Dear Mr. Nokes:

I have received the revised rental pool lease and rental forms which you forwarded with your letter dated May 16, 1997.

After receiving the forms from you, I routed a copy of the proposed procedures for additional internal review. A couple of other questions were raised relative to the procedures. If you can respond to the questions posed below, I will again revise the draft procedures and again send a revised draft to you.

The questions are as follows:

1. If water or space leased to the rental pool is not rented in a particular year, will the lessor be allowed to carry over the water into the next year or will the unrented water revert back to the lessor at the end of the year? You may need to review the by-laws of the water district in order that the answer is consistent with the by-laws of the water district.

2. Does the rental pool intend to rent water for use outside the boundaries of the water district or will rental be for use only within the district? If leases outside the district boundaries are anticipated, will the rental rate the same as within the boundaries?

I appreciate your responses to my letters. Each time we are refining the "package" associated with the proposed rental pool.
