The Bosrd of Directors Have asked me to write to you in hopes you can help us with our problem in regard to the problem we seem to be having in regard to our ditch water. The Terminus Lateral Ditch is water that comes at end of Noble Ditch and irrigates South part of City of Fruitland. The Lateral has been there for 40 years and we pipedit and covered is with dirt about 5 years ago.

The land south of Terminus Lateral has been sold to Fruitland School District and they are building a new middle School on the land. The contractor and School Superintent were told about the pipe line and showed where it was.

They could fine norecording of the ditch being there at the court House so they seem to think we have no rights about the Lateral water. They don't seem to want to give us any easement on each side of ditch but finally did say we could have 5 ft. on one side.

They are now in the process of building the school and the reheavy trucks run over the pipe and have broken it 5 times already. Each time it is repaired it weakens the pipe. They also took out a road that was south of the pipe line and had been used for many years and it also gave some protection for the lateral.

We would like to know where we can get imformation on our rights in regarde to the lateral ditch. We can not afford a lawyer so the Board of Directors would be very grateful if you could send this imformation or tell us where to get it before they ruin our water supply for irrigation.
