The waterusers of Smith Creek # 63 B met at the home of Chairman, Elmer Ireland, March 6, 1995 at 2:00 P.M.

Those attending were Clyde and Luther Cook, Randy and Sandy Davison., Dean Davison, Barbara Ireland, and Linda Werner from Id. Dept. Water Resources.

Secretary read the 1994 minutes and gave County Treasurers Balance Of \$271.08
There were no bills in 1994 so we will not have to have a Budget for 1995.

Dean Davison made Motion and Luther Cook seconded to have all officers same as 1994.
Watermaster, Randy Davison. Chairman, Elmer Ireland. Secretary, Barbara Ireland.
Advisory Board: Jim Venable, Bill Davison, and Representative from Forest Service.
Credential Board: Ron Davison, Dean Davison and Clyde Cook.

Watermaster salary same as 1994. \$25.00 a day for total of five days when called out on Smith Creek. After that whoever calls Watermaster out will have to pay his salary. Watermaster to check with Secretary each time he is called out.

Water Dist. to pay Secretary \$25.00 a year for her expenses.

Linda Werner reported on what the Dept. of Water Resources have been accomplishing on Adjudication. She said depending on situations they plan on doing their field work for this Water Dist. this summer 1995.

Luther reported that before water can be turned in canal the beaver dams will have to be removed. This will take cats and backhoe. Dean Davison and Luther Cook will furnish equipment, other water users will furnish fuel.

Luther Cook made motion Dean Davison seconded to adjourn meeting.
