Resolutions T and T be called Resolutions I and J, be adopted as read and that the items of Jepanes salary and other expenses be fixed as contained therein salary and other expenses be fixed as contained therein.

RESOLUTION C

A motion to be made and seconded, that be authorized to serve as watermaster for Water District #63 from the election at this annual meeting until the next election at the next annual meeting.

RESOLUTION D

A motion to be made and seconded, that the watermaster shall be authorized to appoint such assistants as are necessary, and for such time as may be necessary, for the sufficient distribution of water of Water District #63 for the ensuing year.

RESOLUTION E

A motion to be made and seconded, that the costs be determined by the total amount of water delivered to each canal, both storage and natural flow, and that the Secretary/Treasurer be authorized to collect the Watermaster's Tax directly from the water users in Water District #63.

RESOLUTION F

A motion to be made and seconded, that the amounts payable by each ditch, canal company or other water user, as shown by the approved budget, shall become due and payable on April 10th of this year and said amounts, if not paid, shall bear interest from that date until paid at the rate of 8% per annum, and that no ditch, canal company or other water users shall have the right to demand and receive water, and that the watermaster shall not deliver water to such person until the amount of the tax due and payable from such user, as fixed by the budget, shall be paid.

RESOLUTION G
