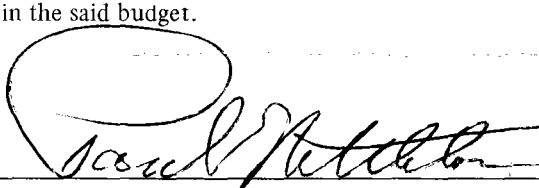
Sections 42-613 and 42-617, Idaho Code Annotated, provide:

If more than one county is designated then said budget shall show the amount to be collected in each county and the water users from which each county shall make collection. * * * "

Meeting called to order at 1:20 PM

Present: Paul Nettleton, Jay Hulet, Don Hartley,
Craig Baker, Rene Tyson, Vicki Tyson and
Cindy Hodges-DWR

In absence of Chairman Elaine Hulet, Paul Nettleton
presided as secretary.

Minutes were read and approved.

Officers were elected (same as last year)

Watermaster was elected at the same salary as
last year (Mary Blackstock at \$30 per trip and
\$30 a mile)

Budget was set (same as last year)

Discussion: Paul reported 4 feet of snow in Silver
City with high moisture content or about $1\frac{1}{2}$ times
normal. Outlook is good for reservoirs to fill
this year. Craig reported Nakas Res as down 2.5 feet
from top. Jay reported his reservoir at only 8 feet.

There was discussion of moving the inlet
measuring device above Hulet Reservoir and decided
that nothing would be done this year while the problem
was being studied.
