ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE WATER USERS OF

WATER DISTRICT No. 57-D

Meeting called to order at 1:20 PM, Jan 8, 1996 at
Owyhee County Courthouse at Murphy

In attendance: Paul Nettleton, Craig Baker, Jay
Hulet, Mike Akli, Don Hartley, and Cindy Hodges, IDWR

Minutes were read and approved.

Officers were elected: Craig Baker, chairman
Paul Nettleton, secretary

Discussion as to watermaster and salary. Paul will
negotiate w/ Mary Blackstock and is authorized
to offer a raise of \$10 per trip (\$40 total).

(Subsequent negotiations required salary of \$50 per trip)

Milage at 30¢ per mile was to stay the same.

Budget was approved.

Paul gave snow and reservoir report. Reservoir is filling
at a relatively fast pace and creek flow is above normal.
Soil in the mountains is near saturation but the snow
pack is below normal. Reservoir should nearly fill
if precip. and snowfall is normal for the rest of the
winter.

Cindy reported that the SRPA court is beginning to
hold objection conferences now. IDWR will serve as
informational or professional witness to the court.
