RE: Early Season Diversions

0800 Jay Hulet phoned, requested copies of Joyce Livestock decree + SRBA recommended irrigation rights. We discussed season of use & historical early uses.

I said court is deciding that, I would not ~~offer an opinion~~ offer an opinion at this point. I prepared the copies and left them for pick-up.

3/14 Paul N. phoned - asked essentially same question - can he irrigate w/ reservoir spilled flows? Reservoir is spilling & there are flows in the creek. I said, as nearly as I can recall: "I cannot tell you that you can, but I am not in a position to stop you at this time." I also reiterated that the court would be the final decision on early season beneficial use.

Related info: Paul just recently submitted District paperwork to County, therefore no bills have been sent. WM still not paid for '95 but has agreed to work in '96 for \$50/trip + .30 mile from home.

RE: Diversions at Hulet Res. Control Structure.

9:00 Phone call from Dan Stevenson / Jay Hulet. Paul

has raised wood headgate @ control box to get flows

Related info:

Paul is also making some diversions directly from MMC, but Jay acknowledged that we have no jurisdiction and was not asking for assistance there.

Is this a Water District issue? After discussion w/ Dave T, I phoned Dan back with the following info:

- Jay is diverting at MMC under a valid permit.
- Paul does not have an acknowledged right to divert prior to April 1, therefore,

- This is a Water District issue, However
- No Watermaster has been appointed because last year's salary is not paid. If Jay & Paul have unresolvable issues at the MMC control structure the WM must be called.

The following must happen before WM will be appointed:

- Someone must give some money to Owyhee County for Sinker Cr account (suggested Jay call for amount = WM salary of his assessment & pay up)
- If funds are sufficient, request WM be paid immediately

- Once verification of payment is rec'd, WM may be called & appointed and may go secure the wood gate as necessary.

1000: Jay phoned, having talked to Dan Steenson.
He feels Paul inferred from our conversation
(Paul & me)
that Paul could use any available flows so long
as the reservoir was spilling. I assured Jay
that I was only speaking of naturally spilled
flows, and I had no control over the message
Paul got, however I could see how he read
more into it. I agreed that I would call Paul &
Clarify but I would not do anything else. If
that information does not solve the problem,
Jay will have to take the steps to call the WM.

Jay's says he is not concerned with the diversions
further down the creek, and is only challenging
Paul's diversion @ the outlet. I concur w/ Jay.

1010 Phoned Paul & left a message that wood gate
should be closed.

RE: Diversions at Hulet Dam

~3pm Paul Nettleton returned my call. He doesn't see any difference between taking spilling or excess flows from the creek channel or from the control box.

Dave explained that until April 1, the storage rights are senior. To the extent that there is excess water after all storage rights have been filled (ie Hulet Res. ^{upper} full & flows diverted as desired to lower Hulet Res.)

Paul may divert under his irrigation rights.

However, diversions at the control box must be coordinated with Jay. If resolution cannot be reached, WM must be called. Diversions by Paul from MMC not under our jurisdiction.

We subsequently phoned the same info to Jay & then Dan Steenson at Jay's request.
