Minutes were read and approved. Officers were elected: Craig Baker as Chairman, Paul Nettleton as Secretary.

Nich offili agreed to serve again as watermaster and was duly elected. Compensation was set at \$50 per trip and 30 ¢ per nicle travel expense

Secretary Soul Nettleton presented a letter from the Owyhee Country Commission regarding collection of water fees. Ofter some discussion it was decided
