THE POINT BEING THAT IF THE 1892 WAS RE-INSTATED THAT IT WOULD AFFECT JUNIOR RIGHT SOMEWHAT. HE FURTHER COMMENTED THAT IF IT WAS JUST 2 OR 3 INCHES IT PROBABLY WOULDN'T MATTER BUT THE DITCH IN QUESTION HAS SEVERAL RIGHTS THAT COULD POTENTIALLY IF STARTED UP AGAIN WOULD HAVE A LARGER IMPACT ON JUNIOR RIGHTS. HE SAID HE DELIVERS JUNIOR RIGHTS WITH AS LATE OF PRIORITY AS AROUND 1950.
