Water master: Marshall has declined the position for the upcoming season. Suggestions as possible water master: Alan, Brian, Morgan and maybe advertise the position.

Derald made motion to have Advisory committee secure the water master. Seconded by Klain. Motion Passed.

Maintenance: Discussed the problem at Monte Blanchards with the culvert. Advisory committee and Gary Blanchard to look into possible solutions. Also were discussed weed spraying, north lateral head gate problems, south lateral silt.

Reed is President of Old Ditch company with Lee as secretary. Discussion was made on whether to keep the water district as a whole to pay for expenses or start to use the two ditch companies to pay for maintenance. Morgan made motion to keep the same with the water district to pay expenses. Seconded by Lee. Motion passed.

Cindy Bird: If water is not used within a five year period you lose the easement. Also assessments and usage have to be kept current in order to call for water.

Cindy also had a question as to who put the culvert in going down the hill at Monte's and is there only one person to use that water. Is it the water districts responsibility?
