CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL AND REMARKS

- The maximum diversion volume is defined as the maximum allowable volume of water that may be diverted annually from the source under this right. The use of water confirmed by this right is limited to the amount that can actually be beneficially used. The maximum diversion volume may be adjusted to more accurately describe the beneficial use or to implement accepted standards of diversion and use efficiency.
- This water right is appurtenant to the described place of use. 2.
- 3. This right is subject to all prior water rights and may be forfeited by five years of non-use.
- 4. Modifications to or variance from this license must be made within the limits of Section 42-222, Idaho Code, or the applicable Idaho law.
- 5. Use of water under this water right will be regulated by the watermaster of State Water District No. 47G.

6. A totalizing measuring device of a type approved by this Department shall be maintained as a part of the diverting works.

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- 7. A measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type approved by this Department shall be maintained on the diverting works in a manner that will provide the watermaster suitable control of the diversion.
- 8. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor exceed a combined annual diversion volume of 1104.0 af for the lands above.
- 9. This right when combined with Rights 47-02316B, 47-02316C, 47-02402, 47-02417, 47-07565, 47-07615, 47-07618, and 47-07642 shall not exceed a combined rate of diversion of 24.71 cfs.
- 10. This right is appurtenant to land designated as DLE No. I-331(943).
