The next matter of business was the discussion of a budget for 1997. Discussion followed with Mr. Crowley stating that there had been a substantial raise in the cost of gasoline during the last year after the adoption of the 1996 budget. After discussion of costs, motion was made by Mr. Swan, seconded by Mr. Heil, that the budget for 1997 in the amount of \$6,050.00 be adopted to cover expenses as follows:

Watermaster's salary	\$3,600.00
Watermaster's gasoline expense	1,450.00
Miscellaneous expense & Social Security	500.00
Secretary's salary	500.00

Upon roll-call vote the proposed budget was unanimously adopted.

The Chairman announced that the next matter of business was the election of a watermaster, whereupon Melvin Crowley was nominated by Mr. Randall Brewer, and seconded by George Swan for Mr. Crowley to serve as watermaster through March 15, 1998. No further nominations were made. Upon roll-call vote, Mr. Crowley was unanimously elected Watermaster for the District for the period through March 15, 1998.

In connection with the matter of the payment of assessments, the following motion was made by Mr. Swan and seconded by Mr. Heil, and adopted by unanimous vote:

"It being desirable that a date different than that fixed by statutes, i.e., June 1, be fixed as the final date upon which the amount payable from each water user as shown by the adopted budget shall be due; and that the water payments be made prior to delivery of any water,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the amounts payable by each water user as shown by the adopted budget, shall become due and payable on May 1, 1997, and said amounts if not so paid shall bear interest at the rate of 8% per annum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no water be delivered by the Watermaster of this District to any water user until such time as the assessments for such water user are paid in full."

The chairman announced that the next matter of business was the election of an advisory board to serve for the 1996 irrigation season. Upon motion duly made by Mr. Brewer and seconded by Mr. Heil, the following persons were nominated and elected as the advisory committee for the water district for the irrigation season of 1997:

Discussion followed regarding the measurements of the usage of water in the upper watershed. It was reported that on Devil Creek south of the highway, three measurements were made during 1996 by the Department of Water resources and Charles Brockway. From these measurements, a use amount would be established. It was hoped this method would be sufficient to use on the upper watershed streams for their consumptive use. The measurements were made above the diversion and stream flow measurements of the stream were made after return flow to the channel. After the parties had time to analyze the figures to be generated by Mr. Brockway and the Department, a determination would be made as to whether this method would satisfy the requirement for measurements.

Doug Jones from the Idaho Department of Water Resources reported that the Department is developing a list of domestic and stockwater rights for the District from the filings made in the Snake River Adjudication case. Notices will be sent out so that water users will be able to review them.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the same was adjourned.
