Acting President, Ryan Cranney, called the annual meeting of the Cottonwood Water Users, to order at 10:10 a.m., on January 24, 2005. The meeting was held at the Oakley Canal Company office at 100 West Elm Street, Oakley, Idaho.

ELECTIONS

Motion by Doug Cranney, that Clint Muhlestein remains Watermaster and Ditchrider, seconded by Ardon Cranney, motion carried.

Motion made by Doug Cranney to retain Mike Cranney as President and the Oakley Canal Company as secretary. The motion was approved.

Clint Muhlestein said Cottonwood really needed to elect someone to watch the finances. Russel Patterson made the motion to elect David Picket as Treasurer, motion seconded by Jared Mitton, motion carried.

Russel Patterson motioned to add Ardon Cranney and Travis Patton to the advisory committee, already consisting of David Picket, Jared Mitton, Russel Patterson, and Doug Cranney, motion seconded by Jared Mitton, motion carried.

BUDGET

The 2005 budget remains at \$5000, a motion by Jared Mitton to approve the A & B resolution to collect and pay the budget, motion seconded by Doug Cranney, motion carried.

MINUTES

Jami Hurd read the minutes, a motion was made by Doug Cranney to accept the minutes, motion seconded by Jared Mitton, motion carried.

A copy of the 2004 water bill was handed out and discussed. David Picket spoke to Clint Muhlestein about their bill. The Cassia County Clerk will send out all of the invoices for the water.

Doug Cranney asked Clint Muhlestein to talk with the Fish and Game about access to the Highline Canal. Russel Patterson has been cleaning out the canal but is having a hard time getting into it for maintenance. Russel Patterson is interested in renting the Oakley Canal

Company's Cat to help with repairs at \$65 per hour. It was discussed and accepted that the water users will benefit from the repairs. The possibility of putting a liner in the bottom of the canal was also discussed.

The annual meeting is scheduled for the fourth Monday of January 2006 at 10:00 a.m.
