OAKLEY, IDAHO WATER DISTRICT 45A JANUARY 15, 1996

The meeting was called to order by the chairman Kay Wells, at 7:10 p.m on January 15, 1996. The meeting was being held at the Oakley High School, Oakley, Idaho. Members in attendance were: Kay Wells, Gerald Marchant, Scott Spearin, Rex Martin, Jared Bedke, Bill Wells, Kevin Smith, Linda Zollinger, Wade Zollinger, Steve Manning, Basil Fairchild, LeRoy Fairchild and Donald Bedke.

Basil Fairchild was nominated for chairman by Wade Zollinger. Seconded by Kevin Smith. Approved by members. Linda Zollinger was nominated for secretary by Kay Wells, Seconded by LeRoy Fairchild Approved by all members in attendance.

Minutes from 1995 meeting were handed out and reviewed. Kay Wells moved the minutes be approved as printed. LeRoy Fairchild seconded the motion. Motion passed.

The financial report was given by the secretary, Linda Zollinger. There is currently \$8,076.64 in the district account. Two bills are not paid. One to Leroy Fairchild for \$3,000.00, and the second to Gerald Marchant for \$60.00. Need to get check book from Robert Bedke to do this.

Discussion followed on the repairs which are needed to be done in the district. None of the repairs were done in 1995. The weirs on Mill Creek need to be cleaned, replaced, and repaired. The weirs by the Steel place, Rose Fairchild's place, and Craig Smith's place all need a lot of work done. Feeder on Spring Creek needs to be totally redone Willows by the Steel place need to be cleaned out. Each member is to have his ditches and headgates clean and in good repair, before water is distrubed. Basil Fairchild as chairman selected three members as an advisory committee for the year of 1996. The advisory committee is Donald Bedkerepresenting Summit Creek, Wade Zollinger representing Spring Creek, and Kevin Smith representing Mill Creek.

Kevin Smith was appointed to check with the flood control board, consisting of Mike Cranney, Paul Searle and Glen Beck about possible help on repairs on Spring Creek, and repairs of areas to help prevent future flood damage.

Discussion on how to distribute water (1st Mill, 2nd Mill, 3rd Mill, etc.) LeRoy Fairchild has a brake down and this will be mailed to members.

Basil Fairchild reported on insurance for the District. It will cost approxiamtely \$750.00 for \$300,000 worth of liability insurance. No motion made.

Nominations were opened for Water Master. LeRoy Fairchild was nominated by Wade Zollinger. Discussion on Kasey Bedke, with Donald Bedke's supervision, Steve Manning was intersted in learning the watermaster job, and Scott Spearin was interested. LeRoy Fairchild said he would accept the watermaster job for 1996. Kevin Smith seconded nomination of LeRoy Fairchild. Donald Bedke with drew his nomination of Kasey Bedke. Motion passed the LeRoy Fairchild will be the Watermaster for 1996 for the wages of \$2,500.00, with the watermaster paying the full Social Security Tax. The watermasters duties will be for the full calendar year. Steve Manning and Kasey Bedke as alternates to go with LeRoy Fairchild and learn the watermaster job. LeRoy Fairchild would be glad to teach anyone interested in learning.
