- 3. Make sure water is turned at a reasonable time or call, unless other arrangements have been made.
- 4. Check with the state and fill out paper work.
- 5. Make sure feeders are correctly measuring the water.
- 6. Beneficial to attend watermaster school in Twin Falls.
- 7. Pay own expenses and taxes.
- 8. Water master is to attend water meeting and report on work needs to be done and problems.
- 9. Make sure all water users receive water schedule card.
- 10. 10% of wages will be withheld until all paper work has been filed with the state.
