Our Deputy has advised me that your diversion at Dittoe 56-D, needs to be rebuilt, and as a result he cannot make accurate measurement of your water.

Idaho Code 42-701 states in part:

"The appropriators or users of any public waters of the state of Idaho shall maintain to the satisfaction of the director of the department of water resources suitable headgates and controlling works at the point where their water is diverted. Each device shall be of such construction that it can be locked and kept closed by the watermaster or other officer in charge, and shall also be of such construction as to regulate the flow of water at the diversion point."

Failure to do so may result in the director of water resources instructing the watermaster to shut off and refuse to deliver at the point of diversion, the water owned by such appropriator or user until the user does construct and maintain such headgates, controlling works or measuring devices or remedy the defects which exist.

Repairs to this diversion need to be done as soon as possible for delivery of water during the 2001 season.

Our Deputy has advised me that your diversion at Haugh 42-A does not have a flow meter, and as a result he cannot make accurate measurement of your water.

Idaho Code 42-701 states in part:

"The appropriators or users of any public waters of the state of Idaho shall maintain to the satisfaction of the director of the department of water resources suitable headgates and controlling works at the point where their water is diverted. Each device shall be of such construction that it can be locked and kept closed by the watermaster or other officer in charge, and shall also be of such construction as to regulate the flow of water at the diversion point."

Failure to do so may result in the director of water resources instructing the watermaster to shut off and refuse to deliver at the point of diversion, the water owned by such appropriator or user until the user does construct and maintain such headgates, controlling works or measuring devices or remedy the defects which exist.

Installation of a flow meter (preferably a Micrometer that registers in CFS) needs to be done as soon as possible for delivery of water during the 2001 season.
