
Sections 42-613 and 42-617, Idaho Code Annotated, provide:

If more than one county is designated then said budget shall show the amount to be collected in each county and the water users from which each county shall make collection. * * * "

RESOLUTIONS PERTAINING TO THE TIME AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE BUDGET AS
ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE WATER USERS OF
WATER DISTRICT No. 31

COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENT

Carl Hoggan moved that no ditch, canal co., or other water user shall have the right to demand and receive water, and the watermaster shall not deliver such water, until full payment is made. Said payment becomes due April 1, and becomes delinquent April 15, and if not paid by April 15, shall bear interest from the date of April 1, until paid at the rate of 8% per annum. That government agencies be exempt from the above provisions to the extent necessary for them to comply with payments according to the provisions of Federal law, and that the watermaster of district 31, be authorized to enter into contract with said agencies of the United States for payment of assessment as provided in the budget. Seconded by Kenneth Bennett, motion carried.

RESOLUTION

A motion was made by Don Parker to adopt the following resolution: Be it resolved that the Clark County Auditor make up a roll of all Water District #31 users to include all Jefferson County users. Be it further resolved that the Clark County Treasurer mail out said billings and make collections if all Water District #31 Water Users to include all Jefferson County Water Users in said Water District #31 boundaries. Be it further resolved that the Clark County Treasurer also make all payments and disbursements owed by Water District #31, which are presented through the proper claims procedures which are common to other Clark County practices. Motion was seconded by Kirk Egbert, motion carried.

Be it resolved that the watermaster or deputy watermaster, be required to furnish a vehicle for all job related duties and activities, to carry out all his responsibilities as watermaster of this water district. Be it further resolved that any and all expenses of operation of that vehicle or vehicles for the water district, shall include but are not limited to fuels and oils, maintenance and repairs, payments of vehicles, licenses, insurance, and any other fees related to operation of vehicle.
