RESOLUTIONS PERTAINING TO THE TIME AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE BUDGET AS ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE USER OF

WATER DISTRICT NO. 32-D

Paul Webster, made a motion to adopt the 4 resolution as stated Brandi Terry, seconded the motion. Motion passed.

COLLECTION OF WATER ASSESSMENT

NO DITCH, CANAL OR OTHER WATER USER SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO DEMAND AND RECEIVE WATER UNTIL FULL PAYMENT DUE IS PAID. PAYMENT SHALL BECOME DUE APRIL 15, AND SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT MAY 15, AND IF NOT PAID BY MAY 15, THE PAYMENT SHALL BEAR INTEREST FROM APRIL 15, AT THE RATE OF EIGHT PERCENT (8%) PER ANNUM.

THE WATERMASTER SHALL NOT DELIVER ANY WATER UNTIL FULL PAYMENT DUE IS PAID.

WATERMASTER TERM OF SERVICE

THE WATERMASTER SHALL BE ELECTED FOR A TERM OF ONE FULL YEAR. THE PURPOSE IS SO THE WATERMASTER CAN SERVE IN THE LEGAL CAPACITY TO DO OFFICIAL BUSINESS FOR THE DISTRICT IN THE EVENT OF EMERGENCIES, LEGISLATIVE ACTIONS, HEARINGS, DISPUTES OR OTHER WATER RELATED OR JOB RELATED ACTIVITIES.

THE WATERMASTER CANNOT BE REQUIRED TO MAKE WATER DELIVERIES BEFORE APRIL 1, OR AFTER NOVEMBER 1, (THE NORMAL IRRIGATION SEASON) UNLESS AN EMERGENCY EXITS. THE WATERMASTER SHALL NOT BE PAID BEFORE APRIL 15, OR AFTER NOVEMBER 1, FROM THE WATER DISTRICT BUDGETED REGULAR FUNDS.

HEADGATES AND WEIRS

ALL CONTROL DEVICES AND MEASURING DEVICES SHALL BE IN GOOD WORKING ORDER BEFORE WATER CAN BE DEMANDED OR DELIVERED. THE WATERMASTER SHALL NOT DELIVER ANY WATER UNLESS SUCH DEVICES ARE IN GOOD WORKING ORDER.

USGS MEASUREMENTS

THEY AGREED TO CONTINUE WITH THE 3 USGS MEASUREMENT.
