Stanton Sr. Water Resource Agent Minutes of the annual meeting of the waterusers of Water District #37N held March 5, 2001, at the Carey City Hall at 2:00 p.m. Present were Bob Simpson, Kathi Peck, Dick Payne, Rick Mecham, Jerry Cenarrusa, Dar Parke, Boyd Stocking, Mike Hennequin, Terry Gregory, and John Cenarrusa.

Little Wood River Irrigation District Board Chairman, Dick Payne, called the meeting to order and asked for nominations for a meeting chairman. Boyd nominated Dick, Dar seconded and voting was unanimous. Nominations were then opened for a meeting secretary. Dar nominated Kathi, Boyd seconded, and the voting was unanimous.

Watermaster Bob Simpson presented the budget for 20001-2002, noting that it represented about a 3% increase over last year. He mentioned that that barely covers the rise in the cost of gasoline. Dar made a motion to accept the budget as presented, Mike seconded and voting was unanimous.

Dick then opened nominations for watermaster for the upcoming water year. John nominated Bob, Mike seconded and voting was unanimous.

Kathi explained the proposed resolution to the group. It moves the watermaster election to the second Tuesday in February to coincide with the annual election for directors of the irrigation district. Hopefully, this will improve attendance at both meetings. Dar moved that this resolution be adopted, Boyd seconded and voting was unanimous.

Bob then gave a report on the snowpack and the water outlook for the summer. He reported 17,200 a/f currently in the dam with an inflow of 100 a/f/day.

Dar reported on the power plant production, noting that the income was substantially less last year than average because of the short water. This year looks to be even shorter.

Bob gave an update on the work he has done with Congressman Simpson's office to bring about a gravity pipeline in the Carey Valley. Our chances look good to get about 75% cost share from a federal government line item appropriation. They want us to be an example of water conservation and energy efficiency, and it would greatly enhance our valley.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:45 p.m.
