Dear Tim,

Thank you for your involvement on the Muldoon area water challenges. As you directed, we had an election of a water master. The vote was done by each of the users having an equal vote. I have had a conversation with Cory Skinner in Twin Falls and from that discussion I have the following understanding:

- 1. The vote should not be an equal vote by all water users.
- 2. All water users are not equal. Fees charged determine authorized votes.

The biggest problem is the re-election of Jim Peterson as the water master. Jim has a conflict of interest. I do not believe it is fair to Jim.

- He is a water user himself.
- He is related to Guy Peterson, another water user.
- Most important, he has been the water master for many years and over the last several years, when we have had a shortage of water and the misuse of the water, he has not perform his duties.

Jim is a very honorable man and I do not want to show any disrespect to him as an individual. However, he has not fulfilled his duties as the water master. The results of the last years speak for themselves.

We are following the instructions regarding the measuring weirs and we will have them in place as directed. We hope all of the others will do likewise.

We request your assistants in eliminating any conflict of interest in the water master. We would also ask for a clarification on the rules in choosing a water master and the fees to be charged. I understand we are not following the rules of procedure.

I sure would like to get this all settled so we can get on with running the ranch as best we can. Ranching is hard enough. We want to follow the rules and we expect everyone else to do the same. I would be interested in understanding more about the water judification process for us. Do you have any guess on the time line?

By the way, I believe it is important to go on record that the woman that is with Guy Peterson, told Blair Crouch, my son, that if our ranch manager, Pete Peterson or our hired man ever went up to check the water on Muldoon Creek that she would turn her dogs loose on them. That threat is being taken very seriously and cannot disregarded. By the way, they have a lot of dogs.
