Dear Mr. Craner;

We have received the minutes of this year's water meeting showing that you have been elected as watermaster of your district for 2009. An oath of office is enclosed for your signature. Once we receive your notarized oath, a certificate of appointment will be issued. By being appointed to your position by IDWR, you are covered by the State of Idaho indemnity bond for up to \$100,000. should legal difficulties arise as a result of your performing watermaster services for your district.

It is my understanding that your district wishes to be re-activated after many years of inactivity. In order to operate as a sub-district of Water District 140, you will need to comply with Sec. 42-600 of the Idaho Code. You need to record your daily water deliveries, which will need to be reported on the Watermaster's Report forms that will be sent to you at the end of the season. A daily-record book is enclosed for your inspection and possible use; while not required, the book is a convenient way to record your deliveries. Whatever method you use, we want your daily records at the end of the season so they can be added to our permanent files for your district. Ted Mason has confirmed that you are to serve on an annual basis. While your starting budget is acceptable as voted on, the delivery cost to each person receiving water will need to be pro-rated at the end of the season based on actual delivery volume. You can show a fixed cost to SWID if you so desire.
