### Tim Farrell spouse, Watermaster 78C

Tim called me regarding Mr. Snapp placing an irrigation pump in Goose Creek on his property. He indicated, Mr. Snapp did have Brundage Res. shares, but no natural flow creek rights for irrigation. Mr. Snapp's property is on the old Keska place which has been subdivided. The question was can he do that? I answered, that he could not just place a new P/D in the creek at will. The Brundage rights have specific points of rediversion to ditches and the Brundage right would have to be modified to reflect the new diversion. He needs to utilize the Brundage ditch conveyance system. Tim said, he would inform Mr. Snapp of the requirements. I told him that if there were continued issues to contact me.

#### Mr. Snapp

Mr. Snapp called to argue his point about the new P/D. He indicated, that Ed Raney said it was ok, because he was uphill of the delivery ditch. I stated, that was not an option to pump directly out of Goose Creek. Goose Creek is regulated by a water district watermaster. Proper transfer actions needed to be taken with the Brundage water right to reflect the new P/D. I also conveyed to him that he did not have natural flow rights, and could not divert water to his property unless the reservoir was being drafted by the watermaster. Mr. Snapp indicated he thought the reservoir was being drafted as the creek was up. I informed him that I had reliable information to the contrary. Beneficial use of the water without delivery of the watermaster would be considered an illegal diversion. He would need to file for a new permit to divert Goose Creek Water, which would be held due to the Salmon River Moratorium.

### Tanya Kirby—Sec. Brundage Waterusers

Mr. Snapp had call Tanya regarding the issues. Tanya had the same conclusions as I, but wanted to confirm her thoughts. She stated, that she was certain there was no flood water rights on the Snapp property—old Keska Place only Brundage storage. I discussed the water rights and maps related to the Snapp property—faxed Tanya copies.

#### Comments

- -Does not appear to be associated with the Campbell Swamp WD rights from legal description
- -Appears somewhat questionable if Brundage water has been historically used if the ditch can not be accessed?
- -Not sure of SRBA claims filed or current processing status for the properties/rights in question


