Thank you for the contacts. I am sorry I did not get back to you earlier. We have been in the field quite a bit the last couple of weeks. I spoke with Gordon Cruickshank and he was very familiar with the situation. As you mentioned, he described their plan to install a pipeline to deliver water to the Hearne property. He said they needed to install a new headgate in order to route the water and contacted IDWR to verify that the change in point of diversion is reasonable. He indicated that a headgate was installed yesterday (Thursday, May 5, 2007) so they can now move forward with the pipeline. I will be out of the office Monday and Tuesday of next week but would be curious to know if you have run across it by then and whether it looks like the proposed system will work for Mr. Hearne.
