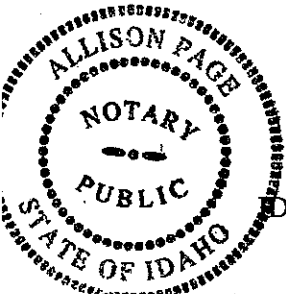

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING IN THE MATTER OF THE PROPOSED CREATION OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE BASIN 71 SUB-DISTRICT WITHIN WATER DISTRICT NO. 170

On April 6, 2006, the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department" or "Director") issued Amended Final Order Creating Water District No. 170 (a copy of the order is posted on the Department's website: <http://www.idwr.idaho.gov/water/districts/UpperSalmon.htm>). That order established Water District No. 170 to include all surface water and ground water rights in the Idaho Department of Water Resources Administrative Basins 71 and 72, other than de minimis domestic and stockwater rights as defined under Idaho Code § 42-111 and 42-1401A(11). The order assimilated existing water districts into Water District No. 170, but provided that they would continue to function largely independently as sub-districts of Water District No. 170. The Director proposes to create an additional sub-district within Water District No. 170 for all of Administrative Basin 71.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) will conduct a public hearing regarding the proposed creation of the sub-district within Water District No. 170, as follows:
