Basin 36/Water District No. 130 Spring Users and Spring/Surface Water Right Holders

Re: Meeting of Spring Users to Discuss Assessments, Voting and Advisory Committee Representation for Water District No. 130, The Thousand Springs Area Water District.

Dear Water User:

The steering committee for Water District No. 130 has met several times since Water District 130 was created last spring. The steering committee is open to participation by any water right holder within the water district or their representatives. The committee has discussed and proposed several alternative proposals for assessments and voting, as well as representation of water users on the water district advisory committee. Participation at these meetings by spring users has generally been sparse and usually limited to just one or two representatives. Ground water users in contrast have actively participated.

At the last steering committee meeting held on October 29, the committee unanimously recommended that a separate meeting be held among the Water District 130 spring users to get their input or consensus regarding water district assessments, voting and advisory committee representation. Attached to this notice is a list of potential options for assessment and voting procedures within Water District 130 that were discussed at the last water district steering committee meeting. Time is very short for you to develop a position on these issues because the steering committee recommendation must be prepared before the February 11, 2003 annual meeting. Thus, I have scheduled a meeting of the spring users for January 21, 2003 for the purpose of facilitating discussion of these issues among the spring users. The meeting at 1:30 p.m. on January 21 will follow the Basin 36/Water District 130 Mediation meeting, which is scheduled on the same day (January 21) and at the same location (Eight Street Center) from 9:30 a.m. to approximately 12:30 p.m.

The spring users also need to discuss the possibility and mechanics of forming a spring user sub-district. A spring area subdistrict could operate much like the ground water districts and irrigation districts presently function within Water District No. 130.

It is important that you, as a spring user, participate in this upcoming meeting and provide input as to how you and fellow spring users wish to be assessed and represented in the water district.

- 1) Assessments set in accordance with Section 42-605. Assessments are made on an equal basis between ground water and surface water diversions using actual diversion records. Since there is roughly a three to one ratio in amount of water diverted between surface water and ground water, then the surface water users may potentially control a majority of the voting at the annual meeting. The advisory committee composition may be independent of assessments and voting (i.e. committee can be 50-50 ground water surface water representation or other ratio as determined by users at annual meeting).
- 2) Assessments set in accordance with Section 42-605A and split 50-50 between the spring/surface water right holders and the ground water right holders (Note: Assessing nonconsumptive surface water users at about 1/3 of the total surface water diversions results in about a 50-50 split between surface water and ground water uses). Voting at the annual meeting would also be split 50-50. Actual surface water and ground water user votes cast at the meeting depend on the number of ground and surface water users present at any annual meeting. Again, advisory committee composition may be independent of assessments and voting.
- 3) Assessments and hence voting, set in accordance with Section 42-605A but split based on estimate of amount of time the watermaster dedicates to administration of consumptive ground water diversions and nonconsumptive surface water diversions. It is roughly estimated, based in part on just the number of diversions, that this would result in a split of about 75 or 80% ground water to 20% or 25% surface water. This approach results in ground water users having majority voting.
- 4) Assess a minimum charge of up to \$50 per diversion. Voting at annual meeting is based on the amount assessed to each water right holder present at the annual meeting (proxy voting limited to representatives of water right holders who have a direct interest in the water right, i.e.; lessee, representative of company owning water right etc).

Note: Under Idaho Code, advisory committee composition is not dependent on type of uses or types of water rights within the district. Committee composition therefore can be different than the assessment/voting splits given in the above scenarios. It was suggested that the advisory committee could include an equal number of surface and ground water users to promote consensus committee decisions and recommendations but that assessments and voting at annual meetings could deviate from 50-50 split. Alternatively, the advisory committee could have more ground water representatives than surface water representatives but operate with the understanding that all committee decisions and recommendations must be made unanimously or have the consent of all members.
