MINIMUM CHARGES

Water District 130 has adopted a minimum assessment charge of \$25. That charge will be applied to:

1. Non-subdistrict water users whose summed pro-rata diversion charges are less than \$25 , and
2. Water users with non-reported diversions who have no other assessed diversions and who are not members of a subdistrict (one charge per water user)

Please contact the Watermaster for specific information about individual assessment amounts

* Non-reported diversions are those with water rights showing rates of diversion greater than 0.04 cfs and authorizing use(s) of water other than for domestic and stockwater, or with water rights showing rates of diversion greater than 0.24 cfs for any use of water, and whose diversions are not presently being measuring and reported to the District
