Dear Mr. Yakovac:

We are enclosing a copy of the decreed water rights adjudicated by Joseph C. Rich, Judge of the Fifth Judicial District in the case entitled David McNutt, et al, vs. Thomas Palmer, et al.

This gives all of the decreed water rights on Carmen Creek showing their amounts and relative dates of priority; also, the filings listed under permit and license rights on Carmen Creek.

In scarcity of water, the permit water rights have to be turned off first as all decreed rights are superior to any permit water rights. Therefore, that might be the reason that the watermaster of Carmen Creek had to shut your water right off in order to fill the decreed water right.

You request to know the point of diversion of the water right listed as "24" in the decree. The decree does not list any points of diversion, but it is a considered fact that the same points of diversion that were established for these rights prior to the rendition of the decree would still be in effect, although not stated in terms of the decree.

From this list of water rights enclosed herewith, you can figure out with the watermaster what right he is delivering to and thus know whether your rights are good or not.
