We received your letter of July 24th in regard to water rights on Carmen Creek.

Permit No. 8390 filed June 13, 1912, shows certificate of Completion of Works was issued to Chas. W. Temple for 3.0 cfs from South Fork of Carmen Creek; point of diversion in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, to irrigate N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 36, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 35, Twp. 23 N., Rge. 22 E.B.M. Mr. Temple did not make proof of beneficial use of the water.

We find no record of a water right on the other two tracts you describe. Thanks for giving the stream. Unnamed streams and springs were also checked.

Dear Mr. Yakovac:

We received your letter of July 24 in which you state that 30 to 50 inches of water flows from your place into Carmen Creek.

Any unappropriated water which flows into a natural stream becomes part of that stream to be used to fill water rights downstream. The waste water from your irrigation is your water until it leaves your property or enters a natural stream. You cannot measure your waste water into the stream and take a like amount out at your point of diversion. You can prevent it from wasting and use such waste water before it leaves your control.

Dear Mr. Herndon:

Returned herewith are two copies of the application for transfer of water right, copy of decree *Nieman, et ux vs. Continental Life Insurance Co.* and copy of contract of sale. The copy of Warranty Deed mentioned in your letter of August 7th was not received.

We only require one copy of the application. The decree shows one-half interest in the ditch to each party, however, it does not show amount of water or priority. The priority of the right shown on the application is March 7, 1929 which is the date the decree was signed.

We find Permit No. 3010, in the name of Ulysses G. Waller, Certificate of Completion of Works was issued with priority of July 3, 1907, for 3.2 c.f.s. from Carmen Creek, point of diversion SE¹/₄SW¹/₄, Sec. 8, to irrigate SE¹/₄NE¹/₄, E¹/₂SE¹/₄, Sec. 32; SW¹/₄NE¹/₄, Sec. 33, T. 23 N., R. 22 E. Notice of proof of beneficial use of water was evidently published, however no depositions were received.

We find Permit No. 13914, in the name of H. P. Wm. Nieman, Certificate of Completion of Works was issued for 0.5 c.f.s. from Carmen Creek, with priority of February 27, 1919, point of diversion NW¹/₄SW¹/₄, Sec. 9, to irrigate SW¹/₄NE¹/₄, Sec. 8, T. 22 N., R. 22 E., B. M. No proof of beneficial use of the water.

The copy of the decree enclosed seems to be full of errors, no amount of water, no priority, the township and range appears to be in error and the point of diversion questionable.
