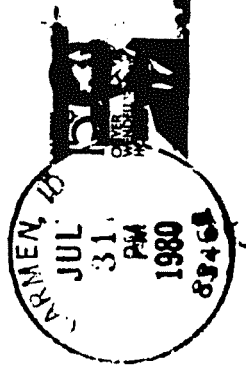

Dear Mr. Smith:

On August 4, 1980, this office received from you, a bill for services including charges for \$250 (salary for the season); and \$300 (for travel expenses); for a total of \$550, for which you requested payment.

At present we are unable to process this bill as our records indicate your present bond is valid only through September 21, while the irrigation season normally runs through October 15, and it is customary that we pay our watermasters for their services at the end of each season.

Since this is the case we would like to request that you re-submit a pro-rated bill for services taking you through the end of the bonding period. Once we receive this in the office we will proceed with the processing immediately.

While we realize it will be inconvenient for you this year, if the irrigation district wishes to retain your services, it will be necessary to apply for a new bond and issuance of an oath of office for the period of September 21 through October 15, 1980.

Please advise us as to your wishes and we will be glad to forward all the necessary forms for these purposes.

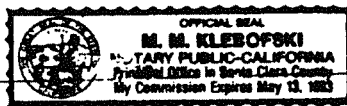

Dear Watermaster:

75-069 according to the decree abstract in this office is appurtenant to the land also within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 3, T. 22N, R. 22E. It appears that the 9.25 acres in question is within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 3, T.22N, R. 22E. Any local surveyor can verify the exact location.

The waters of Carmen Creek are appurtenant to the decreed place of use regardless of the owner and recent land subdivision. Priority and legal right (unless withheld) continue in force per decree.

It would certainly not be out of order to request the new owners to provide you with adequate information for the delivery of their water rights.

On 75-070, I could not locate the place of use for this water right. This would only be of concern if 75-070 was an overlapping water right for the land in question.
