Dear Mr. Pool:

Water District No. 01 personnel measured your canal on July 13, 1973, and found the flow to be 11.9 cfs in excess of your decreed water right.

State law requires that no individual or group of individuals may divert water in excess of their right. Currently, the June 1, 1895, priority water rights are being filled. According to our records, this would cut your canal back to the June 1, 1892 rights, leaving you a total of 31.8 cfs.

We have no record of any storage rights owned by your company. Unless you have evidence to the contrary we must, in order to protect the water rights of other individuals as required by Idaho State Law, ask you to cut the flow at your head-gates to 31.8 cfs. This would be a reading of .73 ft on your gage fifty feet downstream from your point of diversion from the Snake River.
