<u>Assessments</u>: Need to be paid <u>BEFORE</u> the water is turned to the client for the first time. Assessments are paid at the County Courthouse in Burley by April 1, 2017.

<u>Maintenance</u>: Private weirs should be in place, repairs completed, and ditches cleaned before the water season begins. This should include ditch garbage, willows, weeds, and dirt buildup that will interfere with the Water Master's ability to turn the water or the irrigation water to flow readily.

ELECTION of 2016 WATER BOARD MEMBERS

<u>Eugene Matthews</u> was nominated as CHAIRMAN of the Water Board. This was acceptable to Eugene. Positive comments about Eugene's experience on the Water Board, involvement with the irrigation system in the Basin, and knowledge of people involved with 45A and other water districts made Eugene a reasonable choice for chairman.

Through discussion <u>Jared Bedke</u> was nominated as the BOARD MEMBER in charge of matters dealing with <u>Mill Creek</u> with <u>Craig Hawker</u> as his assistant. <u>George K.</u>

<u>Wells</u> was nominated as the BOARD MEMBER in charge of matters dealing with <u>Summit Creek</u>, and <u>Craig Smith</u> was nominated as the BOARD MEMBER in matters dealing with <u>Spring Creek</u>. <u>Vickie Smith</u> was nominated as SECRETARY/TREASURER.

ALL nominees for positions on the Water Board accepted.



WATER REPORT

Danielle Bedke Helms's <u>WATER REPORT of the 2015 SEASON</u> was read aloud and discussed. This report was available for water users to have an individual copy and preread it before the meeting started. (Danielle was unable to attend the meeting because her daughter was having a medical procedure in Salt Lake City. Board Members were contacted about her absence before the meeting and Danielle made the copies for water users to read.)

Nathan Erickson talked about high water and how to measure it. Danielle had a question about measuring and recording high water. She had made an estimate. We are off rotation on high water times, so the Water Master is to report this time as <u>full</u> delivery.

Discussion to hire Danielle Bedke Helms as the WATER MASTER for the 2015 season. All present were in agreement about this. Her wage would be \$5,000 paid in 6 payments of \$750.00 per month (April thru September) equaling \$4,500 and the remaining \$500 paid when her Annual Water Report was presented to the Board.

* ALL water users, present at the meeting, accepted this motion. Eugene said that he would discuss this information with Danielle.



ASSESSMENT

The 2015 assessment was \$8.00 per water share. Point of discussion, brought up by Jared Bedke, was to lower the price per share to \$4.00. This was discussed and the outcome was to keep the fee at \$8.00 per water share for 2015, and then relook at this amount in 2016.

MINUTES

The minutes from the January 12, 2016 meeting were read by Vickie Smith. The minutes were reviewed and discussed by those in attendance. Copies of the minutes from the 2016 meeting and the bank statements from the 2016 year were available for all attendees to review before the reading of the minutes.

MOTION to accept the minutes: George K. Wells

MOTION seconded: Jared Bedke All present approved.

FINANCES

The financial statements were reviewed. We have \$11,601.34 in the 45A account at D.L. Evans Bank as of January 3, 2017. All business transactions for Water Year 2016 have been paid and accounted for, including Danielle B. Helms' end-of-the-year report payment (\$500.00) that she received at the meeting.

ELECTION of a CHAIRMAN and WATER BOARD MEMBERS for 2017

Eugene Matthews was nominated as Chairman of the Board for 2017 by Basil Fairchild. Eugene said that he would be willing to be the Chairman again. Those in attendance reacted positively to this.

The Board Members retained their positions as well.

Craig found that he needed one. Jared Bedke made a motion to amend this position, if

needed. Attendees thought that would work.

WATER MASTER REPORT

Danielle Bedke Helms gave her report about "the happenings" of the 2016 water year. Her report was not quite finished. She was going to do some recopying of her book, before she sent it in to Twin Falls.

Nathan Erickson said that she could just send the book with all of its statistics and notations in, as is. Danielle said that she would send it in as soon as possible. She had several concerns which were discussed by the group..

- (a) Reminder to have private weirs in place, repairs completed, and the ditches cleaned before the water season begins.
- (b) Water assessments need to be paid before the water is turned to a client for the first time.
- (c) Noxious weeds are a concern, especially Canadian Thistle.

Some ideas were for individual users to be responsible for their ditch banks. That led to the distance from the ditch bank? Should a professional be hired to spray for noxious weeds? Suggestion were Casey Bench or Jeff Wadsworth. Another idea was that the water district could buy some spray and share with the users. The noxious weeds issue needs to be discussed by the Board Members and see if they can come up with a satisfactory plan. Possibility of spraying a portion of the creeks this year and having a schedule to spray the creeks a section at a time. Danielle mentioned several spots where she turns the water that need to have willows removed for better water delivery. Owner needs a permit to burn.

NOMINATION and ELECTION OF THE 2017 WATER MASTER

Eugene asked Danielle if she would want to be the Water Master for 2017. Danielle was agreeable to that at the same wage (\$5,000) as the 2016 water year. Eugene, also, asked if there were any other nominees. There weren't any. Everyone was happy to have Danielle as the 2017 Water Master.

<u>MOTION</u> to accept Danielle Bedke Helms as the 2017 Water Master: Jared Bedke <u>MOTION</u> seconded by: Craig Smith

2017 ASSESSMENT FEE

We increased our water fee to \$8.00 per share 2 years ago when we could see that several repair projects were needed. Since we have \$11,000+ in retained funds this year, Basil Fairchild suggested that we reduce the fee to \$5.00 per share, the Jared Bedke said he had figured it out and that \$4.00 per share would give us sufficient money to work with. At \$4.00 per share, we would be adding about \$5,000 to our retained monies. The water users agreed that \$4.00 would be our assessment fee this year. Jerry Marchant mentioned that an emergency assessment fee could be called for if we got into financial distress.

<u>MOTION</u> to accept the reduction of the assessment fee from \$8.00 to \$4.00: Jared Bedke <u>MOTION</u> seconded by: Ryan Hawker

Jerry Marchant told us about his recent trip to Phoenix and how farmers are using drones to spray weeds. It was interesting to think about all of the potential ways that technology may be able to help farmers and ranchers in the future. For example, spraying in areas that equipment has not been traditionally able to get into.

Our annual meeting is scheduled for Thursday, January 11, 2018. Water users want to continue with updates that pertain to use of the water in the Basin.
