
Marsh Creek Water District 45F Water Master's 2016-17 Annual Report

I would like to thank the Water District Members for the overall cooperation on the call of water during this last irrigation season. Sorry that when the moisture was no longer the factor and the junior rights made calls for water, it was not available even though 1210.03cfs was released to the river prior to their call. We were no longer on high water. I believe in most cases we worked as a team when it counted. Marsh Creek Water District members have all paid their water shares accept for one member, which equated to \$7.98 plus late charges this last year. Note, that if not paid, he will be void of irrigation water on said property this coming season.

Note, Marsh Creek Water District is primarily a Surface Water Irrigation District. Water in some cases is diverted into ponds and pumped through pivots, wheel lines, hand lines or just surface irrigation. There are a few Ground Water rights (29), City of Albion with (4) wells handling domestic and fire Protection.

It was a very unusual irrigation season. We went into this year with an abundance of rain and not a real snow pack year, but we had an estimated 19.71" of moisture. The higher altitude was ice which released slowly thus really not causing any prolong high water nor the ground frozen to the point that would create flooding but was more like our area was like a sponge that was completely absorbed with water creating the excessive run off that we had going to the river. I hope my analogue is not confusing.

The snow pack moisture was better than last year in the mountains, but really did not have the moisture that
everyone was predicting to start out with. The rains came at the right times, but created a quick run off the
latter part of May, which for the first time in several years sent 623.81cfs to the river. No one could utilize the
extra water but overall the moisture that developed during the season created good crops and the farmers
were prepared with shorter crop rotation for water conditions of the past seasons.



The water district did end up with a billable CFS of 7,893.28 under the proposed budget of 6899.05 of the 5 yr projected average. Along with the actual costs pushed the actual CFS cost up from the Approved operating budget, thus creating an additional proposed budget cost for 2016. On the positive side of the season there was more miles encountered in distributing water we had, but the fuel costs were lower therefore less funds were spent then the previous year.

But January and February of this closing annual water season, the ground was completely frozen and the
rain that occurred caused extreme run off and flooding, Temperatures were high and we had less moisture
during the time frame of January and February this Fiscal year. Thus sending excessive water to the river

prior to the new irrigation season. An estimated 1853.5CFS was sent to the Snake River prior to our annual water meeting being held March 6, 2017. I am still sending water to the river as of this date of our meeting.

I was able to start turning water back to the upper Albion valley rights dealing with Howell Creek in the middle of Sept., Land Creek, I didn't stop irrigating, but was going with a partial of the Robinsons 1# right. Six-S Ben 1# right was completed with just a partial right of 30 inches in the later part of Sept. The first right, City of Albion, Campus, 6S Merrill and Adam Ward never went on rotation they stayed with their percentages on what water was available which averaged 1.60cfs and working together. I was able to start water delivery on Starth ditch the first part of Oct. along with other Users off of Marsh Creek.

 It will be noted that Howell Creek was the Primary creek maintaining a higher flow than the other two creeks (Marsh & Land Creeks).

Summit Creek that normally extends the upper Users water on Howell Creek by helping those Users on Howell Creek below 1000 south was available during most of the season. Antone-Pine Creek ran very short on the lower meadows and for beneficial use was kept up on the higher meadows which took into effect the springs and possible an additional worked spring in the later portion of the irrigation season and only one User got the maximum flow at one point.

We are entering into 2017 with an abundance of moisture, taking in a good snow pack in the higher elevation and decisions that the farmers will have to consider, either set aside ground and or go with crop's that does not extend way into the late summer and fall. 2016 as you remember, Two of the three major creeks were running above average at this time of year. It's an early flush of snow storage that we count on at a later date.

Oakley Water District 140:

As the Watermaster of 45F, I have appointed Earl Warthen as primary person in representing MCWD45-F at all meetings, with respect to Water District 140. My Alternate Ground Water person is Christopher King. They were both approved at their annual Water District 140 meeting Feb. 2, 2017.

The Water District 45F Board is still working on the possibility for consideration in reading and posting data, generating annual reports for the state dealing with ground water by the watermaster of 45F. This was after Water District 140 staff has done the certifying of wells within district 45F thus eliminating excessive undue cost. This was a consideration by the IDWR Director when it was decided to create Water District 140 and keeping MCWD45F. This yet to happen.

I am requesting as the current Watermaster of 45-F, your consideration for action from this delegation today, for follow up this coming season on the following items that have been ignored in the past:

- Vaughn and Starrh Ditch User's, to have their meeting(s to elect an individual Ditch Rider for their laterals by April 1, 2017. I have in the past set up rotation(s) which will be used when the call has been made, each individual will be charged their percentage of the water released at the POD off the creek. If the individual does not use his or her particular rotation when it comes around, they will still be charged their percentage share of water until the call on that lateral is no longer available to deliver.
 - Also, both laterals will get into compliance dealing with head-gate/weir and measuring devices at all POD's.
- Heritage Campus needs to setup a closed system leading into their pond so when the city is making their call for water they don't end up flooding the town with feedback of the pond or utilizing their share of water when both have called for water.
- All Users in MCWD45F need to check their Decreed Rights for stock water. The issue came about when a protest was filed dealing with the Vaughn Ditch Lateral which Water resources validated no "stock water" right during non-irrigation period (Nov-Feb). Therefore, Six-S Merrill Ranch was given (Vaughn Ditch) a Special Permit dated Nov 23, 2015 thru March 15, 2016 (stock water). Which has expired and no longer exists and this fall after irrigation no longer was available.
 - During my annual water meeting last March (2016) it was discussed to develop a Water Users Association and the Six-S Attorney present created a Resolution to carry it out. Meetings were setup and I the Watermaster, attended all of them. Basically nothing came of them due to the fact the city and campus representation continued to discuss other problem matters other than what the meetings were called for. Therefore, attendance for proper quorum discontinued and the end result a Lateral Association never was created.

Vaughn Lateral & Marsh Creek Delivery of 1st Right:

The City of Albion, central distributing diversion off of Vaughn Ditch Lateral (located on Six S Merrill Ranch) to the cities central point of distribution (piped) to both the city of Albion and the Albion Heritage Group LLC (known as the Campus) receives a full 1.35cfs (Cities call of .91cfs and .44cfs to the Campus).

Note: The city of Albion's new POD/POU transfer of .26cfs was approved for that portion of the Cities .91cfs
to be used to supplement the city's sewage ground (East of Albion) due to a DEQ requirement. Therefore,
the city of Albion has only .65cfs for regular irrigation during regular flow of Marsh Creek. Also, when All of
Marsh Creek has been diverted to Vaughn Ditch Lateral, the transfer (DEQ) does not prevail and the .91cfs
is then available for their full right for irrigation provided the water is available.

Starrh Ditch Lateral:

The Users have yet to comply with a diversion head-gate, weir with a staff gage at the Adams-Meyer diversion on Starrh Ditch to handle the proper delivery of a water call, when the call for 45-0217 and 45-309 is also being called.

- Also, the 9" Parshall Flume (directly off Marsh Creek) needs to be repaired (balanced both horizontal & vertical) in order to get a proper reading.
- The 45-217 Users need to repair their weir. Water is going under and around the weir also, a proper head gate and staff gage is needed.

Most of the decreed surface users have resolved their problems with their delivery systems which have been implemented. But we still have a few diversion and measuring devices that are not incompliance legally, who have yet to adhere or comply too the water districts request with the extension given by the board in our last few meetings. They are:

- (Anton-Pine POD's has yet to comply with weirs, head-gates and staff gauges.
- The same with the Barrett Lateral has yet to comply at individual POD's along the lateral.
- George Kelley's portion of Barrett channel going thru the Elk Ranch needs maintained so water can be
 delivered when called by the GCW Ranch on the Upper Bench meadows. The GCW party has been unable
 to maintain the ditch due to the Elk. The so called weir used at the point going onto George Kelley's property
 is right on the Albion Highway road shoulder, which needs to be moved closer to his property line and a
 proper weir plate and staff gage.

Some weirs that were implemented need additional work done to them and culvert channels maintained with maintenance and cleaning of surface growth. Note primary problem see below with <u>Water Speedwell</u>.

Additional Action Items:

The Rose Ranch and Albion Ranch 2006 need to get in compliance with both the Broad Hollow and Rose Creek entries to their storage Pond(s) with POD's exiting with proper measuring devices for distribution of logging water to the appropriate place of use.

- Broad Hollow Creek POD is where the lateral leaves the original creek channel going westward to the area in which it drops into the enclosed system along with Rose Creek as it enters the storage pond and also where Rose creek leaves and is used as surface irrigation in the regular rose creek channel.
- The Users that are on the old rose creek channel need to file on the waste water that leaves Rose Ranch as
 was the situation this last 2016 irrigation season to where it ends up eventually linking with Marsh Creek.
 You know who you are.
 - Those that apply need to know they will have to create POD's and require the necessary means of measurement devices.

There is a new weir at the Cities approved POD on Marsh Creek which will need to be GPS by IDWR and at the same time I will be requesting additional POD's to be GPS.

Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership / and Water Transfers: Individual's who purchase property need to get their water right transferred and property deeds inline and registered with Idaho Department of Water Resources and the MCWD Watermaster. The new property owners have 90-120 days to record!

Ranches exchanged ownership:

 The Black Jack Ranch no longer owned by the Mahoney's was purchased by the Albion 12 Investments LLC under the direction and operation of Mike & Brian Merriman. The Ranch will stay separated as The Rose Creek Ranch and the Albion 2006 Ranch LLC.

- Goodman Ranch LLC purchased by Leroy & Karla Robinson.
- Ina Droz Ranch LLC purchased by Randy & Janet Brackenbury.

The Legal Pump Diversions within the creek's: The User will call the watermaster for delivery and the Water District through Allen Merritt's ruling, if the water right is down to a portion of the right it has to go to the next in line, it is shut off regardless. If an individual persists to use a pump then there shall be a monitor required instead of guessing on usage.

 Also, if pump has been used after they have been shutoff and notified, there is no water for the decreed date, the pump will be pulled with a fine. The following is an option that <u>SHALL</u> be implemented by the Watermaster.

Veronica anagallis Aquatica, common name "Water Speedwell". Cassia County Weed Abatement, Gordon Edwards indicated that Rodeo will take it out. This weed has been mistaken as Night Shade by some. It is throughout all creek channels, delivery ditches within the Albion Valley and also the reservoirs. This weed is in the process of chocking off the channels.

Veronica anagallis-aquatica L.

Water speedwell

Family: Scrophulariaceae

Range: Throughout the United States.

Habitat: Near aquatic environments, including ditches, slow streams, pond and stream margins, wet meadows, and marshy places.

Impacts: Can form dense stands in aquatic systems and impede the flow of water. Also weedy in Canada and South America.

Water speedwell is an emergent biennial or perennial to 3 ft tall, with glabrous opposite leaves. Plants typically develop a system of rhizomes and/or stolons. The stems are erect to spreading, sometimes creeping and often rooting at lower nodes. The leaves are usually sessile and 1 to 4 inches long with a smooth to serrate margin.
