## Re: Removal of East Fork Fish Creek Structures – Your 12/2/2019 Letter

Dear Mr. Luke:

On December 2, 2019, you extended the deadline for Jerry Weaver, watermaster, to coordinate removal of structures placed in East Fork of Fish Creek by The Nature Conservancy ("TNC") from December 2, 2019 until February 4, 2020. The extension of the deadline was in response to my November 27, 2019 letter to you, in which I informed you that my client, Fish Creek Irrigation District ("FCID"), was in discussions TNC to resolve their differences.

I am happy to inform you that FCID and TNC have continued to meet. Additional work has been done on the reach and structures in question through drone flights and studies; however, additional time is still needed to reach a resolution. A meeting is scheduled between FCID and TNC. Anticipating that an agreement can be reached, FCID requests that the February 4, 2020 deadline be extended by three weeks until February 25, 2019.
