Proof of Beneficial Use Due & Possible Change in Water Right Ownership

RE: Permit 63-34689

Dear Property Owner or Authorized Representative :

The Department of Water Resources (Department) has reason to believe you may be the owner of all or part of the property associated with water right permit 63-34689 (permit). The permit authorizes a total diversion rate of 0.58 cubic feet per second (cfs) of ground water for irrigation use in portions of Section 24, Township 04N, Range 02W, B.M., Canyon County.

According to Department records, the current permit holder is MDC LLC. A condition of the permit requires the permit holder to submit a proof of beneficial use statement to the Department on or before **May 1, 2024**. The Department notified MDC LLC by certified mail at 7270 N Tree Haven Pl, Meridian ID 83647. Douglas Carnahan of MDC LLC notified the Department by phone that the property at the permit place of use has since been sold.

If the required proof statement is not submitted on time, the permit will lapse, and authorization to divert water for the permitted use will end. You are being notified in case you have an interest in the permit and want to submit the proof statement.

Water right permits are considered real property. Permits are normally conveyed from one owner to another by being included in the conveyance documents for the land where the water is to be used. Please submit the appropriate documentation and fees to the Department if the permit was conveyed to you.

Along with the ownership change notice, you may submit a *Statement of Completion for Submitting Proof Beneficial Use* or a *Request for Extension of Time* form to meet the permit requirements.

I am enclosing a copy of this permit, a map representing the permit place of use, and a copy of the correspondence from the current permit holder of record. **Proof of**

beneficial use is due May 1, 2024. This permit will lapse if no further action is taken, and authorization to divert water for the uses described above will end.
