Water master report by Jaxon Higgs
Assessment \$86,010 total
1 delinquent assessment of over a year

Summary of budget
Will not need to use all the \$14,443 remaining, not as many water master duties, transfers, etc.

Water budget
Snow pack lower than last year, but reservoir is fuller than last year. Surface water system should fill. The ground water system may suffer because of less injection and incidental recharge.

Ground Water Management Area
Discussion of all the different management boundaries
Anyone not in the critical groundwater area is inside the new "groundwater management area"
Anyone managing under the critical groundwater areas will be asked to still manage under that and not do anything additional for the ESPA groundwater management area.
Legislation will be proposed to extend the rule 50 boundary to include all the tributaries.
Conversation of whether these changes can be made through legislation vs rule making.
It is not suspected that those participating in critical groundwater areas are going to need to do anything more under the new groundwater management or expanded rule 50.

Don Pickett asked department, why isn't everyone part of a critical groundwater area? Corey King suggested that this is the purpose of conversations with the ground water management area. Don Pickett, does the IDWR see a present injustice? Corey, that's being discussed by the new director.
