2022 Water Year Water District #41

The 2022 water year in Rockland valley was extremely dry. Younger water rights received cuts as early as mid May and continued throughout the summer. The East Fork of Rock Creek continued to struggle to meet ditch demands, consequently the Bench, Tyler, City, West Ditch and others were short of water throughout the summer. Water flow from the South Fork of Rock Creek was low, but steady relative to years prior. The Landing ditch and other diversions on the south fork had stream flows similar to prior years. Hot weather and relatively little rainfall made it difficult to keep crops growing, especially on ditches that were cut early.
