The 2023 water year in Rockland valley was an improvement from prior years. The majority of water users had access to full rights throughout the growing season. Water flow from the South Fork of Rock Creek was the only area that experienced short water, which is consistent relative to years prior. The Landing ditch and other diversions on the south fork had stream flows similar to prior years. Timely rainfall helped mitigate the shortfall, and the majority of the valley was able to experience a good water year in the district.
