<u>Minutes</u>: David asked Mary to read last year's minutes. Minutes of the March 2022 Annual Meeting were read and approved with no corrections.

<u>Treasure's Report</u>: The checking account has \$268.01. There were no expenditures for 2022-2023.

<u>Old Business</u>: The MOU has been tabled permanently. No updates on Quail Hollow Golf Course purchasing Boise City Canal rights.

New Business: Mike reported that water levels in all the wells look good. Water usage is down slightly. New meters were installed in Quail Hollow, Terteling and Edwards wells for better monitoring. The Edwards well met IDWR accuracy standards during calibration checks performed by Corbin Knowles. Mike will contact Mr. Niznik about his well, installing monitoring device on the well and water usage. Dana Hofstetter proposed that we consider temperature as another method of identifying changes in aquifer due to the re-injection that occurs in the Downtown Boise area. Mike said temperature data are provided by some of the well users, but it may be difficult to obtain representative temperatures. He said that he will pursue a methodology to incorporate temperature in his analysis.
