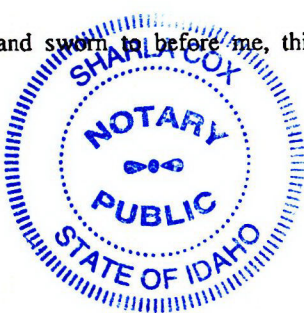

Dear water users,

The measuring of wells in the Bancroft-Sand water district commenced on May 9, 2016. Again this reading was before pumping and irrigation had begun. It appeared that it was going to be an early spring; however, the weather turned wet and cool until about the middle of June. Therefore, the demand for ground water was delayed until later in the season.

Of the seven wells I measured, five had water levels above the 2015 level to start the season; however, two wells were below the 2015 level.

As I reported in last years notice the Pond well was being used to water cattle. This required locating another abandoned well in the same general area. The state department of water resources decided on a well east and north of Todd Holbrook's residence. I started measuring this well on July 12th. This well is about 200 feet deep, and is the deepest I measure. From July to November the depth varied .95 feet.

The wells generally returned to a more tradit-

itional. pattern with the lowest reading occurring in July. On four of the wells this was the case, but on the new Warren & Lloyd well and the Larsen well the low point was in August.

I'm not sure the reason for the low point in water levels in August in 2015 and 2016, but it could be the cool wet springs in both years. Irrigators didn't need the water until later in the summer, and the crops did well with the plentiful rainfall early in the growing season.

Enclosed herewith is a copy of the Watermaster's Annual Report for the past season.

The same has been prepared by the watermaster and approved by this Department in conformity with Sections 42-610, 42-614 and 42-615, Idaho Code.

During the 1993 legislative session, the legislature enacted a new law which amends Section 42-619(9), Idaho Code and removes the independent financial audit requirement for most state water districts. The new law, referenced by Section 67-450B, Idaho Code (copy enclosed) identifies minimum audit requirements for all local government entities. Under the new statute, the governing body of any local government entity (i.e.; water district) whose annual budget does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) has no minimum audit requirements under this section. This means that any district which handles its own money and whose budget is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less does not have to have an independent public account firm conduct a financial audit every few years as previously required by Section 42-619(9).

Please note that only the statutory requirement regarding the independent financial audit has been changed. Districts handling their own fund (i.e.; districts who collect and / or disburse their own funds) must still submit their own statement of the water district's financial affairs at the end of each fiscal year. As recommended in the Department's February 16, 1993 letter and the 1993 Watermaster Handbook, a copy of the financial statement may be submitted either with the annual water masters report or with the minutes of the annual meeting for the ensuing year. An example of an annual financial statement may be found in Appendix C of the 1993 Watermaster Handbook.

The purpose of this letter is to remind all water districts that workers compensation insurance is required for all water district employees. This requirement applies to all water districts in Idaho, regardless of annual budget. Insurance should be applicable at least to all paid water district staff, including the water master as well as watermaster assistants, advisory committee, secretary and treasurer. The costs associated with workers compensation insurance is paid directly by the water district and should be considered an expense of the district. For information about obtaining insurance costs etc., please contact the Idaho State Insurance Fund. The State Insurance Fund has offices in Boise, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho Falls, Pocatello and Twin Falls. Water Districts are also reminded that all paid water district staff may be subject to state and federal taxes. These tax requirements will vary depending on salaries and total income of each watermaster or employee. 

Dear water users,

In 2015, I started measuring wells in the Bancroft-Sund water district on May 25, 2015. Due to the wet spring of 2015, irrigation and pumping was delayed almost three weeks compared to the May 5th start up in 2014. Like 2014 my May 25th reading was taken before irrigation and pumping had begun. As an average the well levels were up approximately 1% overall from the 2014 readings. Even though the winter was relatively mild the wet spring made up the difference, and put well levels in the plus column.

This year was an anomaly. In the sixteen years, I've measured wells in the Bancroft-Sund water district usually the lowest reading occurs around the 24th of July; however, this year four of the wells reached their lowest points in June. The other three wells reached their lowest points in August. I'm not sure why this occurred.

There was a change of ownership of the Pond well on the former Don Rigby property. The well is no longer on non-use. The new owners are watering cattle from this well, and it's logical to assume the cattle

would drink more in August than July because August is usually hotter. However, it doesn't explain why the other four wells reached their low points in June.

As a consequence of the Pond well coming back into use we no longer have a "control well" that isn't being used. Therefore, a new "control well" will be needed to compare against the active wells.

Next year it will be interesting to see if the low point of well water levels occurs in July like past years or if the anomaly of 2015 signals a change in the water table.
