Annual Meeting Minutes
January 16, 2018

Water District No. 161 annual meeting was held at the Mountain Home Junior High School on Tuesday January 16, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.. Refer to attached sign in sheet for attendees.

Chairman David Ascuena called annual meeting to order.

Chairman David Ascuena asked everyone to take a minute to review last years (January 17, 2017) annual meeting minutes. John Kieffer made motion to accept minutes as written, second by Jim Blanton. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed.

Watermaster Nick Miller talked about 2017 year was mainly trying to identify water right owners and where they are located. Nick hired deputy watermaster Ed Van Etten to help locate wells and meet with owners. Next year (2019) is the year that the measuring devices need to be installed. There are about 485 water rights in this district; approximately 200 will be required to have measuring devices. That is approximately 360 wells. Nick said sometime this spring a reminder letter will be sent out reminding everyone of order regarding when measuring devices need to be installed and working.

Ed Van Etten said that he had put some information on the back table regarding approved flow meters, distributor names, phone numbers and website addresses for anyone that needs the information.

Chris provided financial report. As of tonight Water District 161 has \$18,447.07 in their checking account. She also said there is \$8,106.18 in accounts receivable. She stated that some of the accounts receivable may or may not be collected. Reasons are water rights owners haven't been located, water rights have been abandoned, incorrect calculation for billing, or owners will not pay. Chris says she hopes to collect between \$1,000 - \$2,000 of receivables. Nick is helping her with collections. Motion made by Jim Blanton to accept financial report, seconded by Kathy Ferbrache. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed.

David Ascuena talked about 2018 proposed budget. The advisory board recommends the same budget as last year \$46,426.00. Discussion regarding the cash in the bank reducing the amount that is to be collected or to collect the \$46,426.00. Discussion about collection process if someone doesn't pay when due. Nick said we can send them a cease and desist order. Norm Semanko from NEVID LLC asked about water rights that are established but are not developed. Nick said that he would have to look at each situation for collection and meters. Motion made by Teresa McCallum to collect \$46,426.00 for 2018 budget, seconded by Larry Jewett. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed.

Discussion about 2018 selection of Advisory Committee. Motion by John Kieffer to elect David Ascuena and Eric Orr to represent large irrigators, and Jim Blanton to represent domestic for Advisory Committee. Seconded by Larry Jewett. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed. Kresta Davis-Butts from Idaho Power was appointed for the Commercial/Industrial representative, Dani Lopez was appointed for Mtn. Home Air Force Base, and Matthew Bundy was appointed for the municipalities. No other representatives were in attendance for Commercial/Industrial, MHAFB, or Municipals so appointments to Advisory Committee were approved by an all aye vote. Motion by John Kieffer to elect Larry Jewett to represent small irrigation on the Advisory Committee. Seconded by Jim Blanton. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed.

John Kieffer made motion to select IDWR/Nick Miller for Watermaster. Seconded by Larry Jewett. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed.

Jim Blanton made motion to select Chris Alzola as Secretary/Treasurer. Seconded by Kent Frisch. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed.

Teresa McCallum made motion to approve 2018 proposed Resolution with the above changes to the Advisory Committee. Seconded by Dave Kellerman. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed.

Discussion regarding 2019 meeting location and time. It was decided to hold annual meeting Tuesday January 15, 2019 location Mtn. Home Jr. High if available at 7:00 p.m.

Nick presented power point presentation of installed flow meters. Discussion about battery operated meters and problems with batteries. Nick said they have improvement the battery ones. Discussion about variance if installation of flow meter doesn't meet standard. Nick said to get in touch with himself or Ed to look at issue before installing. Meters are to be in place by 2019 irrigation season.

David Ascuena asked if there were any other items that needed to be discussed or comments from the floor. None made.

Motion by Larry Jewett to adjourn. Seconded by Randy Ramsey. Vote taken, all in favor, none opposed, motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m..

DISTRICT CREATION AND BOUNDARIES

Adopted 2016

Water District 161 consists of the area and water rights as defined by the Preliminary Order Creating Water District No. 161 ("Order"), dated February 29, 2016. The district includes all ground water rights in the Administrative Basin 61 and a portion of Basin 63 as shown in the map attached to the Order, except rights used for domestic and stock water purposes as defined by Idaho Code § 42-111 and 42-1401A.

ADVISORY COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

Adopted 2016

It is herewith resolved that an advisory committee shall be selected to provide input to the watermaster and the Director of IDWR. The advisory committee will meet as often as needed to address the structure, governance and operation of the district. Seven water users or water right owners, or representatives of entities owning water rights within the district shall comprise the advisory committee. The advisory committee members for the ensuing year shall represent all water users within the district and should represent the following types of water uses:

- Small irrigation (less than 10 acres)
- Large Irrigation (2 members)
- Commercial/Industrial (includes Dairy use)
- Municipal (cities)
- Domestic
- (non-exempt domestic use such as sub-divisions, community wells, mobile home parks etc.)
- Mtn. Home Air Force Base

ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPLACEMENTS

Adopted 2018

It is herewith resolved that, in the event a member of the WD161 Advisory Committee resigns or is otherwise unable to continue to serve on the committee, the remaining members of the water district 161 advisory committee are authorized to select a replacement member to serve until a successor is selected by the users at the next annual meeting.

ANNUAL MEETING DATE**Adopted 2016**

It is herewith resolved that the Annual Meeting for Water District 161 shall be held on the third Tuesday of January of each year at a time and place to be determined each successive year unless the Director of IDWR should find it necessary to change the meeting date or unless changed by resolution of the district at any annual meeting.

ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES**Adopted 2016**

Copies of the minutes of the annual meeting and all approved resolutions shall be filed with the Director of IDWR immediately after the annual meeting in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-605 (5).

WATERMASTER DUTIES**Adopted 2016**

The Watermaster shall perform his or her duties as required by Chapter 6, Title 42, Idaho Code and in accordance with:

- a. Direction and guidance provided by the Director of IDWR;
- b. The annual water district resolutions adopted herein;
- c. Guidance and input from the WD161 Advisory Committee.

WATERMASTER TERM OF SERVICE**Adopted 2016**

As provided in Idaho Code § 42-608(4), watermaster's term of service shall begin upon appointment by the Director of IDWR immediately following the annual meeting election and continue until the next annual meeting, or until a successor is appointed and qualified under the provision of Section 42-604, Idaho Code.

ENTRY OF LANDS BY WATERMASTER**Adopted 2016**

It is herewith resolved that the watermaster and any watermaster assistants are authorized as employees of IDWR under Idaho Code § 42-1701(5) to make reasonable entry on lands within the district, in accordance with IDWR policy, to carry out the duties of the watermaster as instructed by IDWR. These duties include but are not limited to:

1. Inventory of diversions in the district, including inspection of conveyance infrastructure and place of use of water.
2. Measuring and recording rates of diversions, and regulating diversions as necessary.
3. Monitoring the place, period, and nature of use of water to identify unauthorized diversion and use and/or to determine compliance required by any agreement or order of IDWR.

DEPUTY WATERMASTER**Adopted 2017**

The Watermaster is authorized to select one person who, upon appointment by the Director of IDWR, shall be employed by Water District No. 161 as a Deputy Watermaster to assist the Watermaster in performing his duties and responsibilities as provided by Idaho law.

DEPUTY WATERMASTER COMPENSATION**Adopted 2017**

Deputy Watermasters are employees of Water District No. 161, to be paid a monthly salary as specified in the adopted budget and will be reimbursed for mileage at the federal reimbursement rate in effect at the time the mileage was incurred. Monthly Salary will be pro-rated for portions of months worked at the beginning and ending of service.

TREASURER COMPENSATION**Adopted 2017**

The Treasurer will be paid as independent contractor on a flat fee of \$3,500 annually.

COLLECTION OF THE BUDGET AND DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS**Adopted 2017**

It is herewith resolved that the adopted budget for Water District No. 161 be collected from the water users by the Water District No. 161 Watermaster as provided by Idaho Code § 42-618. The Watermaster will make an assessment to each water user in pro-rata amounts as determined by the budget which is formally adopted at the annual meeting. All funds shall be deposited in a bank account maintained by the water district at US BANK in Mountain Home, ID. Treasurer shall disperse funds from water district bank account using two-party signature checks signed by Treasurer and one member of the Advisory Committee.

MINIMUM USER FEE**Adopted 2017**

It is herewith resolved that a minimum charge of \$75.00 per water right owner shall be assessed. Whenever the prorated charge to a user is less than \$75.00, that user will be assessed \$75.00.

FINAL ASSESSMENT DETERMINATION**Adopted 2017**

It is herewith resolved that, in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-612 (5), the assessment amount for each user as shown in the adopted budget shall constitute a final determination of the amount due for that year.

DISTRICT PAYMENT TERMS**Adopted 2017**

It is herewith resolved that the following payment terms be put into effect:

1. Annual Assessments shall be payable on or before April 1. Any other billing is due within thirty (30) days of the billing date. The postmark date will be considered the date of payment. Accounts not paid by the due date shall be charged in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-617 which provides for a late fee of 10% of the amount due and interest of 1% per month.

2. The Watermaster will terminate water delivery to any water user whose assessments are not paid in full within sixty (60) days of the billing date and will not resume delivery until that user's amount due is paid in full.

DISTRICT FISCAL YEAR**Adopted 2017**

It is herewith resolved that the fiscal year for Water district No. 161 be defined as February 1st to January 31st. The fiscal years shall be referred to using the year of the meeting during which the budget for that fiscal year was adopted.



Adopted 2016

WATERMASTER DUTIES

Adopted 2016

The Watermaster shall perform his or her duties as required by Chapter 6, Title 42, Idaho Code and in accordance with:

- a. Direction and guidance provided by the Director of IDWR;
- b. The annual water district resolutions adopted herein;
- c. Guidance and input from the WD161 Advisory Committee.

WATERMASTER TERM OF SERVICE

Adopted 2016

As provided in Idaho Code § 42-608(4), watermaster's term of service shall begin upon appointment by the Director of IDWR immediately following the annual meeting election and continue until the next annual meeting, or until a successor is appointed and qualified under the provision of Section 42-604, Idaho Code.

ENTRY OF LANDS BY WATERMASTER

Adopted 2016

It is herewith resolved that the watermaster and any watermaster assistants are authorized as employees of IDWR under Idaho Code § 42-1701(5) to make reasonable entry on lands within the district, in accordance with IDWR policy, to carry out the duties of the watermaster as instructed by IDWR. These duties include but are not limited to:

1. Inventory of diversions in the district, including inspection of conveyance infrastructure and place of use of water.
2. Measuring and recording rates of diversions, and regulating diversions as necessary.
3. Monitoring the place, period, and nature of use of water to identify unauthorized diversion and use and/or to determine compliance required by any agreement or order of IDWR.

DEPUTY WATERMASTER

Adopted 2017

The Watermaster is authorized to select one person who, upon appointment by the Director of IDWR, shall be employed by Water District No. 161 as a Deputy Watermaster to assist the Watermaster in performing his duties and responsibilities as provided by Idaho law.

DEPUTY WATERMASTER COMPENSATION

Adopted 2017

Deputy Watermasters are employees of Water District No. 161, to be paid a monthly salary as specified in the adopted budget and will be reimbursed for mileage at the federal reimbursement rate in effect at the time the mileage was incurred. Monthly Salary will be pro-rated for portions of months worked at the beginning and ending of service.

TREASURER COMPENSATION

Adopted 2017

The Treasurer will be paid as independent contractor on a flat fee of \$3,500 annually.

COLLECTION OF THE BUDGET AND DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS

Adopted 2017

It is herewith resolved that the adopted budget for Water District No. 161 be collected from the water users by the Water District No. 161 Watermaster as provided by Idaho Code § 42-618. The Watermaster will make an assessment to each water user in pro-rata amounts as determined by the budget which is formally adopted at the annual meeting. All funds shall be deposited in a bank account maintained by the water district at US BANK in Mountain Home, ID. Treasurer shall disperse funds from water district bank account using two-party signature checks signed by Treasurer and one member of the Advisory Committee.

MINIMUM USER FEE

Adopted 2017

It is herewith resolved that a minimum charge of \$75.00 per water right owner shall be assessed. Whenever the prorated charge to a user is less than \$75.00, that user will be assessed \$75.00.

FINAL ASSESSMENT DETERMINATION

Adopted 2017

It is herewith resolved that, in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-612 (5), the assessment amount for each user as shown in the adopted budget shall constitute a final determination of the amount due for that year.

DISTRICT PAYMENT TERMS

Adopted 2017

It is herewith resolved that the following payment terms be put into effect:

1. Annual Assessments shall be payable on or before April 1. Any other billing is due within thirty (30) days of the billing date. The postmark date will be considered the date of payment. Accounts not paid by the due date shall be charged in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-617 which provides for a late fee of 10% of the amount due and interest of 1% per month.
2. The Watermaster will terminate water delivery to any water user whose assessments are not paid in full within sixty (60) days of the billing date and will not resume delivery until that user's amount due is paid in full.

DISTRICT FISCAL YEAR
