Water District No. 29H - Marsh Creek Annual Meeting Minutes January 9, 2019



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The annual meeting of Water District No. 29H ("WD29H"), Marsh Creek and tributaries was held in Downey, Idaho at the Marsh Valley Senior Center on January 9, 2018, at 6:00 p.m. The roster of attendance is attached.

The meeting was called to order by Ralph Wheatley, 2018 Meeting Chairman at approximately 6:05 p.m. The first order of business was to elect a meeting chairman. Allan Kay nominated Ralph Wheatley. The nomination was seconded by Corey Webster and passed unanimously by voice vote.

Chairman, Ralph Wheatley, took the floor and asked Dianna Burden to preside as meeting Secretary and she accepted. Chairman Wheatley welcomed everyone including Steve Visosky, with IDWR. He thanked everyone for working together.

Dianna Burden, Meeting Secretary, read the annual meeting minutes from February 15, 2018. Morgan Evans made a motion to accept as read. Lynn Bastian seconded the motion and all were in favor. None opposed.

Watermaster Report:

Watermaster, Brad Maddox, said he started his job on April 2, 2018. He installed a GPS system on his phone for tracking diversions and put together a book with pictures and diversion points. The booklet will remain property of the District. Brad said he was going to need everyone to call him when you turn your water on & off. Once the measuring devices are installed, you will not need to call.

Robby Barnes asked about the accuracy of the measuring devices. Phil Foster with Valley Implement said it is very important for the measuring devices to be installed correctly and he discussed some specifics.

Brad discussed the importance of determining what devise will work best for your individual situation. Brad reminded everyone that the deadline to request an extension form IDWR is July 2019. Otherwise measuring devises will need to be installed by 2021. Brad thanked everyone for their support and looks forward to working with everyone again this year.

Treasurer's Report:

Dianna Burden reported that Water District stayed within the \$20,000 budget. WD29H used \$530 from the contingency to cover some additional mileage for Brad. We collected \$18,938 and the actual expenses totaled \$16,309. The checking account balance is \$7,121.17 as of 12/31/18. Outstanding invoices total \$1,475, cumulative for the past 2 years. The 2019 assessments should be similar to the prior two years, but we are still waiting on readings from a couple of water right holders with measuring devices. Dianna reminded everyone that address change forms need to be completed, signed by the water right holder and mailed to IDWR so they will receive all mailings. There is no charge for filing an address change forms

Business Items:

Chairman Wheatley discussed the Proposed Resolutions that were put together during the November 2018 Advisory Committee meeting. He opened the floor for questions on the 2019 proposed budget as outlined in item 4 of the Proposed Resolutions. Randy Bertagnole motioned the 2019 proposed budget be adopted as outlined in item 4 of the Proposed Resolutions. Doug Johnson seconded the motion and the motion passed by verbal vote. None opposed.

Proposed Resolution item 6, election of the Watermaster. Randy Bertagnole motioned Brad Maddox remain as Watermaster. The motion was seconded by Gradyn Staley; the motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Proposed Resolution item 7, election of the Treasurer. Lynn Bastian motioned Dianna Burden remain as Treasurer. The motion was seconded by Randy Bertagnole; the motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Proposed Resolution item 15, election of the Advisory Committee: Nomination made by Lori Davis for the current committee to remain in place, seconded by Ken Hall, all in favor, none opposed.

ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The advisory committee members for the ensuing year shall be the following:

Member #1: Kathleen (Kathy) Spiegel (small irrigation user)

Member #2: Lynn Bastian (large irrigation user)

Member #3: Demar (Dee) Gilbert (large irrigation user)

Member #4: Ralph Wheatley (large irrigation user)

Member #5: Tony Hancock (municipal / non-irrigation user)

Chairman Wheatley turned the time over to Steve Visosky with the Idaho Department of Water Resources. Steve discussed the State's business of administration and delivery of water based on priority date same as Snake River. Normally 1910+ must rent water because curtailment is normal. Plan accordingly, explore options to mitigate over the next 2 years.

Lynn Bastian stated that we do not have other water to draw from, are we lining up for disaster? Steve stated that many ideas for mitigation existed within this district. Some examples are: Use the water supply bank, rent water from the bank, build a pond or reservoir. Junior users might come together and pool and rent together. Lynn asked if there was funding help from the State. Steve replied no. But they could pool funds and check out other resources.

Corey Webster asked if curtailment was based on the district or individual users, and if he could rent his water to his neighbor? Steve replied it is on individual priority dates. You can rent your water through the Water Bank. You can give the Water Bank a contract as lessor and lessee and the Water Bank will take their 10% fee and mail lessor the difference. It must be rented for a season and not by the week Water from the bank is delivered using the same priority date. Water must be used to remain active, so if you are not

using it, put it in the water bank. It does not reset, it pauses while in the bank. For example, if water was used for three (3) years and went to the water bank for seven (7) years, it will come out with the same three (3) years.

How do users in WD29H get treated fairly? Steve said IDWR is backing up Marsh creek and Portneuf River when they attend meetings. Lori asked if WD29H is advised when WD1 have their meetings. Steve suggested the WD29H initiate a meeting with WD1.

District Changes:

Steve discussed the State Statues requirements for the Watermaster and billing.

Measurements devises are not required for 5 acres or less. The Watermaster is responsible for recording and reporting measurements. Water right holders will be billed based on actual usage from water on paper.

Goals: Starting in 2020, everyone will have measuring devise unless you have a variance. So, think about the measuring devise types that will work for you and mitigation. Steve gave some variance examples. But you need to show that you are working on installing a measuring devise. Corey asked if financial hardship could be considered an exception. Steve's reply was, it will be hard to get approved.

Ground Water:

The State is taking action. There will be a public notice and hearing. Ground water is not by priority date, unless a surface user contacts the state if they are being injured. There might be a new district or a large district could encompass both ground and surface water.

Chairman Wheatley said the Advisory Committee would get together and discuss some ideas.

Having no further business, Randy Bertagnole motioned the meeting be adjourned till next year. It was seconded by Gradyn Stayley and all were in favor.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.

2019 RESOLUTIONS

1. DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

Water District 29H is composed of the entire Marsh Creek drainage basin to its junction with the Portneuf River excluding Water District 29B (Garden Creek and tributaries) and Water District 29G (Birch Creek and tributaries including Cherry Creek) and is located in Bannock County. WD29H includes all surface water rights in the district.

2. WATERMASTER DUTIES

The Watermaster shall perform his or her duties as required by Chapter 6, Title 42, Idaho Code and in accordance with:

- a. Direction and guidance provided by the Director of IDWR;
- b. The annual water district resolutions adopted herein;
- c. Guidance and input from the Water District 29H Advisory Committee.
- d. Guidance from the IDWR "Watermaster Handbook"

3. WATERMASTER TERM OF SERVICE

As provided in Idaho Code § 42-608(4), watermaster's term of service shall begin upon appointment by the Director of IDWR immediately following the annual meeting election and continue until the next annual meeting, or until a successor is appointed and qualified under the provision of Section 42-604, Idaho Code.

4. RESOLUTION SETTING THE 2019 BUDGET

It is herewith resolved that the 2019 operating budget for Water District 29H is as follows:

Watermaster Wages \$18/hr. (\$10,000 total)
Treasurer Wages \$2,500
FICA/Medicare/Workers Comp. \$2,000
Vehicle Mileage for Watermaster \$3,000
Office Supplies/Misc. \$600
Contingency \$1,900

Total \$20,000*

* Budget line item totals shown are estimates; actual line item costs may vary, but the total cost incurred for the district cannot exceed \$_20,000_ during this fiscal year.

5. ELECTION OF WATERMASTER

It is herewith resolved that Brad Maddox be elected as Watermaster for Water District 29H for the ensuing year.

6. TREASURER COMPENSATION

The Treasurer will be paid as an independent contractor on a flat fee of \$2,500 annually.

7. DISTRICT TREASURER

It is herewith resolved that Dianna Burden is appointed as Treasurer for Water District 29H until a successor is elected or appointed. The duties of the Treasurer will be to maintain financial records, disburse water district funds, and to prepare or authorize a review of the district's financial records.

8. COLLECTION OF THE BUDGET AND DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS

It is herewith resolved that the adopted budget for Water District 29H be collected from the water users by the Water District 29H Treasurer as provided by Idaho Code § 42-618. The Treasurer will make an assessment to each water user in pro-rata amounts as determined by the budget which is formally adopted at the annual meeting. All funds shall be deposited into a bank account maintained by the water district at Ireland Bank in Downey ID. The Treasurer shall disperse funds from the water district bank account using two-party signature checks signed by the Treasurer and one member of the Advisory Committee.

9. ASSESSMENTS

Whereas Idaho Code Sections 42-612 and 42-615 require that proposed water district budgets and annual assessments to individual right holders be prorated based on the amount delivered or used by individual right holders during the past season or seasons (not to exceed five seasons) and, whereas no records of water delivery currently exist in the newly created Water District 29H; it is therefore resolved that Water District 29H will estimate annual water use for all irrigation rights using the following formulas:

Estimated seasonal use (Total AF) = Total authorized acres of irrigation x 3.5 AF / acre

Estimated annual water use for municipal, non-irrigation use water rights, or water users with recorded actual use with approved IDWR measurement methods, shall be based on actual records of water use maintained by the right holders, subject to approval by the watermaster and IDWR. In the event that water measurement records do not exist for such use, water use (Total AF) shall be estimated by the total authorized diversion rate (CFS) x 1.9835 (AF per day/CFS) x 180 days (approximately six months of continuous use at full authorized diversion rate) or the number of days authorized by the water right if the season of use is less than 180 days. If the estimated total water use (Total AF) for such use is greater than the authorized volume limit of the water right, the total water use (Total AF) will be the volume limit authorized on the water right.

10. MINIMUM USER FEE

It is herewith resolved that a minimum charge of \$50 per water right owner shall be assessed. Whenever the prorated charge to a user is less than \$50, that user will be assessed \$50.

Surface water rights that are used solely for domestic and stock water purposes, including incidental irrigation up to one-half acre, or other small uses that are consistent with the use limits defined by Idaho Code Section 42-111, and instream stockwater rights as defined by Idaho Code Section 42-113, shall be exempt from any water district assessments.

Irrigation rights limited to one-half acre or less shall also be exempt from water district assessments.

11. FINAL ASSESSMENT DETERMINATION

It is herewith resolved that, in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-612 (5), the assessment amount for each user as shown in the adopted budget shall constitute a final determination of the amount due for that year.

12. DISTRICT PAYMENT TERMS

It is herewith resolved that the following payment terms be put into effect:

1. Annual Assessments shall be payable on or before June 1. Any other billing is due within thirty (30) days of the billing date. The postmark date will be considered the date of payment. Accounts not paid by the due date shall be charged in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-617 which provides for a late fee of 10% of the amount due and interest of 1% per month. 2. The Watermaster will terminate water delivery to any water user whose assessments are not paid in full within sixty (60) days of the billing date and will not resume delivery until that user's amount due is paid in full.

13. DISTRICT FISCAL YEAR

It is herewith resolved that the fiscal year for Water District 29H be defined as the calendar year.

14. ADVISORY COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

It is herewith resolved that an advisory committee shall be selected to provide input to the watermaster and the Director of IDWR. The advisory committee will meet as often as needed to address the structure, governance, and operation of the district. Five water users, water right owners or representatives of entities owning water rights within the district shall comprise the advisory committee. The advisory committee members for the ensuing year shall represent all water users within the district and should represent the following types of water uses or geographical areas:

Advisory Committee Structure:

- (1 member) Small irrigation user paying a minimum assessment (< 25 acres in 2017)
- (3 members) Large irrigation user paying a regular assessment ((more than minimum) \geq 25 acres in 2017)
- (1 member) Municipal or non-irrigation

15. ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The advisory committee members for the ensuing year shall be the following:

Member #1: Kathleen (Kathy) Spiegel (small irrigation user)

Member #2: Lynn Bastian (large irrigation user)

Member #3: Demar (Dee) Gilbert (large irrigation user)

Member #4: Ralph Wheatley (large irrigation user)

Member #5: Tony Hancock (municipal / non-irrigation user)

16. ANNUAL MEETING DATE

It is herewith resolved that the Annual Meeting for Water District 29H shall be held on the second Wednesday in January of each year at a time and place to be determined each successive year unless the Director of IDWR should find it necessary to change the meeting date or unless changed by resolution of the district at an annual meeting. The next Annual Meeting will be held on January 8, 2020.

17. ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

Copies of the minutes of the annual meeting and all approved resolutions shall be filed with the Director of IDWR immediately after the annual meeting in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-605(5).

18. ENTRY OF LANDS BY WATERMASTER

It is herewith resolved that the watermaster and any watermaster assistants are authorized as employees of IDWR under Idaho Code § 42-1701(5) to make reasonable entry on lands within the district, in accordance with IDWR policy (further described in Administrator's Memorandum "Entry Upon Private Property for Routine (Non-Enforcement) Investigations and Data Collection" dated September 16, 2003), to carry out the duties of the watermaster as instructed by IDWR. These duties include but are not limited to:

- 1. Inventory of diversions in the district, including inspection of conveyance infrastructure and place of use of water.
- 2. Measuring and recording rates of diversions, and regulating diversions as necessary.
- 3. Monitoring the place, period, and nature of use of water to identify unauthorized diversion and use and/or to determine compliance required by any agreement or order of IDWR.
