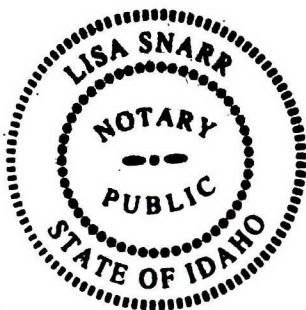

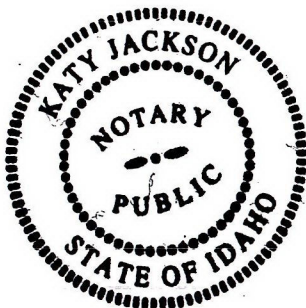

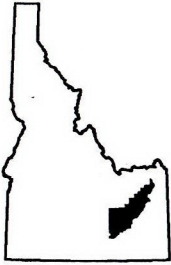

1:30 p.m.

Tim Deeg called the meeting to order at 1:45 p.m. Other advisors in attendance were Neal Powell, Scott Clawson, Rich Line, Walter Gay, Marla Tribble and Dane Watkins. Lyle Swank, Ernie Carlson, Gene Hansen and Tim Luke of IDWR and Lisa Snarr from Water District 1 were also in attendance.

The first item on the agenda was to approve the minutes from the June 29, 2006 advisory meeting. Dane motioned to approve the minutes as prepared; Neal seconded the motion, which was approved by all in attendance.

The next item on the agenda was the financial report, which was given by Lisa Snarr. Lisa presented the Water District 120 Profit and Loss statement, which showed the districts expenses from November 1, 2005 through October 1, 2006. This report showed both the actual expenses incurred as well as the budgeted amount for the year. Lisa said the expenses incurred to date (\$23,360) are well below the amount that had been budgeted (\$74,700) due to significant changes in the staff both with IDWR and Water District 1. IDWR had hired temporary staff rather than full time employees this year which contributed to the lower costs and Terry Klipfel resigned her position as Secretary for the Water District and her position had not yet been filled. Lisa then discussed the Balance Sheet for the Water District stating the Water District income is held in two separate bank accounts—one held with the Bank of Commerce which is not interest bearing and one with the Idaho State Treasurer which is interest bearing. Lisa asked if the advisors had discussed the preparation of a set of rules of some sort that would help guide the direction/procedures of administering the balance between the two accounts and Tim said he had worked on drafting the “rules” and would hopefully complete them soon. Lisa then discussed the Accounts Receivable balance and discussed the assessments that are past due. Lisa is concerned about the accounts that have not paid for over a year and asked if they had decided on what could be done to collect on those accounts. Ernie stated a resolution must be voted on at the next annual meeting that states the Watermaster can cease diversion of water for any assessment not paid. Ernie gave an example of a resolution Water District 130 has and said a similar resolution would work for Water District 120. Tim Luke said he has been involved with other districts in the same situation and suggested that official letters be sent to try to resolve the issue first. If those letters are not responded to, then we can send out a collection letter from the Attorney General’s office indicating the action to be taken if the assessments are left unpaid. Ernie said we could work on a letter to send to the users with past due assessments to try to limit the number the Attorney General will have to handle. Dane motioned to approve the financial reports as presented. Walter seconded the motion, which was approved by all in attendance.

The next item on the agenda was the Water Supply and Rental Report from Lyle Swank. Lyle gave a brief overview of the water year indicating there was roughly 1.8 million acre-feet supplied. He also discussed the leases made through the Rental Pool as well as the private

leases that were made. Tim Deeg discussed the risk that participants in the Rental Pool face when they participate in the Rental Pool process. Lyle discussed the Bureau's participation in the Snail and Salmon protection and their role in renting water to facilitate those efforts. Tim Luke noted the Bureau uses several sources to obtain the water they need.

Tim Luke then discussed the activities the Department of Water Resources has been or is currently working on highlighting the involvement with the ESPA Water Districts and proposed Water Districts. Water District 110 was created in March of 2006 and IDWR is currently providing Watermaster services to them. There is a hearing to expand Water District 120 to include Basin 25, they also proposed a small portion of Basin 35 be included—an order has been drafted but is not yet signed. Interim administration has been started for Water District 100 and a hearing will be scheduled for next month to get the process started. Basin 36 around Carey is creating ground water districts. Other efforts IDWR is focusing on include updating the ESPA Groundwater model, updating the surface water modeling tools and updating the accounting program for water rights. Tim discussed the 2006 field PCC audits that were conducted throughout the ESPA. Tim gave an update on the CREP program stating the total number of acres approved through the initial process as of September 20, 2006 was 6,200 acres including 4,300 acres in Bingham County. Tim is in the process of drafting a Memorandum of Understanding between the District and IDWR and will have it ready to discuss and review at the next meeting.

Gene Hansen then gave a report of his activities related to Water District 120 since the last meeting. Gene discussed the satellite imagery that he has used to identify violations of water usage. Gene showed a few examples and explained the satellite imagery is often only the first step in determining if water is being used in a location other than it is intended. The next steps include an actual site visit, a letter including the photograph identifying the problems, correspondence between the user/owner to determine the circumstances and finally determine the next course of action. Gene said he had completed 176 of 196 site visits for the year. The remaining 20 sites had not been visited due to timing/circumstances between Gene and the user/owner. Gene stated the remaining tasks are to: Investigate Water Rights vs. Water Usage, Inventory the Water Right Transfers, Well Depth Measurements, Learn New WIMIS System and Update WIMIS.

Tim Deeg then gave the Chairman of the Water District Report. Tim said water users are primarily waiting for the Director's order to come out in response to Judge Wood's decision. A hearing has been postponed until the end of October but Tim and others anticipate it will be postponed again. The Supreme Court hearing is scheduled for December 8th and the decision should be reached some time in January 2007. Tim discussed the Mitigation water status indicating Water District 120 has not had to use any Mitigation water this year. Tim noted the next meeting will be just before the annual meeting to discuss the Resolutions to be presented.

There was no other business to discuss. Neal motioned to adjourn. Dane seconded the motion and all approved to adjourn the meeting at 4:45 p.m.

Monday, January 30, 2006

Tim Deeg called the meeting to order at 1:08 p.m. Other advisors in attendance were Scott Clawson, Craig Evans, Stephanie Mickelsen, Richard Mayer, Marla Tribble, Gaylen VanOrden, and Dane Watkins. Lyle Swank, Ron Carlson, Ernie Carlsen, and Tim Luke of IDWR and Wendy Murphy and Terry Klipfel of Water District 1 were also in attendance.

Tim asked Gene Hansen to provide the watermaster report. Gene discussed water supply, showing comparisons of Snowtel sites between April 1, 2005, and April 1, 2006. Gene gave a combined summary of WD 120 and East Measurement District sites. In all, Gene said, there are 442 sites between WD120 and the East Measurement District. He said of those, 187 sites were visited. He gave a breakdown of the types of measurements taken. In addition to routine site visits, there were 26, WD120 audits done. Measurements were very close to those taken by the ground water districts. There was some brief discussion about the collection of data via pump cards and non-reporters. There was talk of adopting a resolution that would allow the water district to impose a charge on persons not reporting their water usage as required. There was also some discussion about a resolution to deal with folks not paying their assessments. The committee decided to let the watermaster work toward resolution of these issues without adopting new resolutions.

Ron Carlson asked if Gene had some water level data to show advisors. Gene said that he did not have it for today's meeting, but advisors had been provided it at an earlier meeting. Ron suggested incorporating the water level data at the annual meeting and advisors agreed.

Scott Clawson asked if there was enough data with the measurement programs to enable measurements to be done on a less frequent basis. There was some significant discussion about this, and Tim Luke said IDWR would look into it. Ron said that water district water masters are required to provide reports of the amount of water diverted by a district to the Director. He said the advisors should look at the issue in the context of a water district, not a measurement district. Ron said water uses may want to consider how to get the most out of what is being imposed upon them, and said some strategic planning may be important, indicating that depth to water information may become more important than other information.

Wendy Murphy discussed 2005 expenditures and the 2006 proposed budget. The proposed budget includes an IDWR contract of \$60,200, a WD1 contract of \$11,500, Report/Office Supplies & Mailings of \$500, Auto & Travel Expenses of \$0, Misc. Equipment rental of \$2,000, and meeting expenses of \$500. The total 2006 proposed budget presented was for a total of \$74,700. One member asked if water district monies were in an interest bearing account. Wendy said it they were not and indicated that a change needed to be made. Tim Deeg suggested moving some of the district's money into CDs. Tim also asked for some information on the department's suggestion for watermaster before the committee votes on the proposed budget. Tim Luke told committee members that IDWR is suggesting that Ernest Carlsen replace Lewis Rounds for WD120. He would also be the suggested watermaster for water districts 100 & 110. There was some discussion on how watermaster expenses would affect the WD120 budget proportionately. After more discussion about budget breakdowns, Tim Deeg asked for a motion to adopt the 2006 proposed budget as presented by Wendy to present to members at the annual meeting. Dane Watkins made the motion with a second by Scott Clawson. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

There was some brief discussion about the resolutions, but other than proposed changes in years and dates, the only other proposed change was to vote to present Ernest Carlsen as the proposed watermaster at the annual meeting. Dane Watkins made a motion to replace Ernie as watermaster, and present the resolutions to folks at the annual meeting with the proposed changes. Marla Tribble seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Tim Luke gave updates on the creation of proposed water districts. There were also some questions in regard to assessments should water users find themselves within the boundaries of a new water district, and about possible changes in ground water district boundaries to bring in some of these folks.

Tim talked about new legislation (Statute 42-620) that would allow the state to form an advisory committee and ultimately bill the various districts for use and maintenance of the ground water model. Tim said this would most likely happen sometime in 2007. Ron Carlson said it would be a good idea to present this at the annual meeting and have suggestions for representatives to sit on the committee. Tim showed an example of an excel sheet breakdown of the water districts and how such a sheet might be used for this committee when determining the amount proportionate to each district.

Tim Luke talked about a new "online" test database that the department is trying to put into operation for the various ground water districts to use when entering data. Tim said that diversions would be linked to water rights.

Tim Deeg gave an update on the water call, the Director's order, and the obligation of 27,700 acre-ft. of water to be provided by ground water users. He said they had been working to purchase roughly 20,000 acre-ft of water from WD1. Some of this water was provided by WD1 members. They include New Sweden Irrigation, Snake River Valley, The Peoples Canal, & FMC, and Palisades storage. Because they were still short and needed to meet the needs of Water District 120 & 130, they pursued purchasing high lift water. The legislature also allowed for funds (in the form of a loan), available through the water board for approximately 2 ½ million dollars for the 78,000 acre-feet available. 41,000 acre-feet were used in WD130, and the other 37,000 was used to meet Mitigation Inc.'s obligation for '05. In turn, we are guaranteed a minimum of 11,000 acre-feet, or up to the amount of water we leased to them. Tim said there will be 37, 000 acre-ft for 2006 if the reservoirs fill, but we still need 40,000 acre-ft of water for WD130 projects. Tim also said he didn't think the cost of water this year would be quite as high, and that they were still pushing to get a hearing with the Director about the order. He also discussed the "CREP" program and possible credits available. Tim talked about the need for a coordinated effort between various water agencies such as IDWR & FSA, to provide easily accessible data (such as maps & water rights), for determining un-irrigated ground, etc. Last, Tim reminded members of the annual meeting to be held on the 13th of February at the Red Lion Inn in Idaho Falls at 2:00 p.m.

Tim asked if there was any other business. Stephanie Mickelsen asked if there was any benefit to not going with IDWR for watermaster duties, etc. Tim explained the benefits in doing so for now, but said it might be a possibility in the future. There was no more business.

Dane Watkins made a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Stephanie and the meeting adjourned at 4:35 p.m.

The water users of water district 120 meeting at the annual district meeting on February 13, 2006, at the Red Lion Inn in Idaho Falls, Idaho, HEREBY ADOPT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTIONS:

1. That the watermaster perform the duties as required by Chapter 6, Title 42, Idaho Code and in accordance with:
 - 1) The duties described in the Final Order Creating Water District 120, signed by the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR), February 19, 2002, including:
 - a) Curtail illegal diversions;
 - b) Measure and report the diversions under water rights;
 - c) Enforce the provisions of the stipulated agreements approved by the Director, and;
 - d) Curtail out-of-priority diversions determined by the director to be causing injury to senior priority water rights if not covered by a stipulated agreement or a mitigation plan approved by the Director.
 - 2) Direction and guidance provided by the Director of IDWR pursuant to Idaho Water Law.
 - 3) The annual water district resolutions as adopted herein.
2. Ernest Carlsen be elected the watermaster for Water District 120. That the Director of IDWR appoint Ernest Carlsen, an employee of IDWR, to provide watermaster services for the ensuing year.
3. As provided in Idaho Code § 42-608(4), the watermaster shall serve throughout the entire year after election at this meeting and upon appointment by the Director.
4. The water users of Water District 120 hereby empower the elected advisory committee to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Water District and the Director of IDWR that will provide for the following:
 - a) Compensation of the watermaster and all related water district expenses for the 2006 fiscal year shall be provided by the water district.
 - b) The budget for Water District 120 for the ensuing year will be set at this annual meeting in resolution 10. Appointment of a district treasurer for fiscal year 2006 will occur during a regular or special meeting of the advisory committee of Water District 120 before assessments from the water district are sent.
 - c) The watermaster shall maintain an office for the ensuing year within the IDWR Eastern Regional Office, located in Idaho Falls, Idaho.

- d) IDWR will provide office space, vehicles and the use of all necessary office and field equipment in exchange for compensation as set in the 2006 budget. This arrangement shall not give Water District 120 any ownership interest in any IDWR office space and equipment.
 - e) Districts identified herein are expected to fund, at their own expense during the 2006 fiscal year, personnel and equipment necessary for measurement and reporting of diversions within these districts.
 - f) Water District 120 will assume full responsibility for all expenses of Water District 120 following this annual meeting on the second Monday of February 2006.
- 5. Diversions in Water District 120 that are not already measured by one of the districts identified herein and also have a diversion rate allowed by their water right in excess of 0.24 cfs shall be measured directly by the water district in the ensuing year and assessed for measuring and reporting at the following rate;
 - a) \$50 per diversion
 - b) \$0.10 per AF for measurement
 - c) \$0.10 per AF for Administrative purposes
- 6. Water District 120 includes one or more ground water districts, irrigation districts or other geographical areas where the source of water or nature of water use is common among water right owners and users. The following ground water districts and irrigation districts may already be measuring and reporting diversions on their own to promote efficiency in the administration of water rights and water management.
 - 1) Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District
 - 2) Bingham Ground Water District
 - 3) Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District
 - 4) Falls Irrigation
- 7. These districts designated above may have employees who measure and report diversions to the water master of Water District 120 and IDWR. The water master of Water District 120 may therefore appoint employees or agents of these districts as assistant watermasters for purposes of measuring and reporting water use to the watermaster of Water District 120. The water district watermaster and the Director of IDWR will provide direction and guidance to assistant watermasters for measuring and reporting of diversions in these districts, including but not limited to the following:
 - a) Each district responsible for data collection shall provide an annual report of diversion data to the water district watermaster in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-606, § 42-708, § 42-709, and the direction provided by the Director of IDWR.
 - b) Assistant watermasters shall cooperate and coordinate with the water district watermaster and IDWR in sharing water use information.

- c) The regulation of diversions, including curtailment of diversions and other water right enforcement actions, shall be the primary responsibility of the water district watermaster and IDWR.
- d) The designated districts will first be given the opportunity to resolve unauthorized diversions, or other enforcement matters before action is taken by the watermaster or IDWR.
- e) To the extent that assistant watermasters may otherwise be involved in the regulation or enforcement of diversions, such involvement will be under the instruction of the watermaster and the Director of IDWR.

8. WHEREAS, the water district meets in regular annual session, as provided by state law, and;

WHEREAS, an advisory committee shall be elected at each regular annual session to represent the interests of the water users and to provide input to the watermaster and the Director of IDWR, and;

WHEREAS Idaho Code 42-605 provides for voting by water users and election of an advisory committee, the water users of Water District 120 hereby resolve that the credentials for voting in any district meeting and for serving on the district advisory committee will be as follows:

- a) The advisory committee shall consist of 11 members, of which no more than 3 of these shall represent non-irrigation water users. And be it further resolved that when available there shall be at least three committee members from both the Aberdeen-American Falls Ground Water District and the Bingham Ground Water District and at least two committee members from the Bonneville-Jefferson Ground Water District.
- b) Must be a water user of the district as evidenced by a valid water right or an assessment for water delivery the previous year.
- c) Must have paid all assessments owed to the water district.
- d) WHEREAS Idaho Code 42-605 has provided for the election of an advisory committee for Water District 120;

HEREBY BE IT RESOLVED, that Water District 120 advisory committee shall be charged with the responsibility for the appointment of member(s) to serve as advisor(s) to the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer Monitoring Committee as Defined By Idaho Code 42-620.

9. BE IT RESOLVED that the Water District 120 budget will be approved for a fiscal year that begins November 1 and ends October 31.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Water District 120 advisory committee shall hereby be authorized to adapt an interim water district budget for the period between November 1 and the next annual meeting.

10. WHEREAS, Water District 120 is self-sufficient and responsible for all costs incurred,

BE IT RESOLVED that the budget for fiscal year 2006 be set at this annual meeting as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED that the stated budget represents an assessment of \$0.10 per acre-foot for the average yearly water use for the period between 2000 and 2005. Also included is the measurement assessment as stated in resolution 5 and a \$25.00 per diversion minimum assessment for those diversions that are in the water district, not measured by the water district or any other entity, and have an allowed diversion rate below 0.24 cfs but not including domestic water rights as described in Idaho Code §42-111.

11. The annual Water District 120 meeting shall hereafter be held on the second Monday of February, of each year unless the Director of IDWR or the Water District 120 advisory committee should find it necessary to change the meeting date or unless changed by resolution of the district at any annual meeting.
12. Copies of the minutes of the annual meeting, the budget as approved, all resolutions approved, and the report prepared in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-615, shall be filed with the director of the Department of Water Resources in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-617.

13. The watermaster of Water District 120 shall be responsible for submitting to IDWR annual reports showing water use and such other information that may be deemed necessary by the Director of IDWR in accordance with Idaho Code § 42-606, § 42-708, and § 42-709.
14. The watermaster and assistant watermasters are authorized under Idaho Code § 42-1701(5) to make reasonable entry on lands within the district to carry out the duties of the watermaster as instructed by IDWR. These duties include but are not limited to:
 - a) Monitoring diversion and measuring rate and volume of water diverted from ground water and other public water sources.
 - b) Measuring the depth to water in wells.
 - c) Monitoring the place, period, and nature of use of water to identify unauthorized diversion and use and to determine compliance with mitigation provisions required by agreement or order of IDWR.
15. WHEREAS some small diversions would have regular assessments less than the amount required by the Water District to maintain their account,

WHEREAS many of these small diversions are not currently measured by the Water District, ground water districts, or the irrigation district. and;

WHEREAS measurement of diversions smaller than 0.24 cfs that irrigate 5 or less acres is cost prohibitive and the water use for many of these diversions can be estimated.

BE IT RESOLVED that Water District 120 will have a minimum charge of \$25.00.
